Dates: 19th to 21st of August 2022

Location: Motala, Sweden

Class: Snipe

Organizing authority: Motala Segelsällskap, MtSS.

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 All boats shall display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 1.3 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.
- 1.4 When the water temperature is below +14°C a competitor shall wear clothes that prevents from hypothermia, i.e. wetsuit or drysuit.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All boats competing shall have a third-party liability insurance.
- 2.2 The event is open class and the person in charge shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or their national authority.
- 2.3 The person in charge who is a Swedish citizen shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 2.4 A competitor shall be at least thirteen years old the same year this event takes place.
- 2.5 Boats, or boats with competitors, from Russia and Belarus are not allowed to participate.

3. Entry

3.1 Boats may enter the event by registering online at Sailarena <u>https://www.sailarena.com/sv/se/club/mtss/nm-i-snipe-2022/</u> not later than 2022-08-07.

3.2 The entry fee is 1,300 SEK and is paid in Sailarena when making the entry. If the entry is withdrawn not later than 14 days before the event, or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee will be refunded.If the event is cancelled because of Covid-19 reasons, the entry fee will

4. Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registration of the whole crew shall be made in Sailarena not later than 2022-08-19.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership, possible competition license and valid measurement certificate or similar.
- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water, the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.
- 4.4 A competitor that has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the race committee.

5. Sailing instructions and information

- 5.1 Sailing instructions and other official information will be available at the official notice board at www.mtss.se.
- 5.2 The race committee will when possible and appropriate broadcast information regarding the course, starting times, safety etc. on a VHF channel that can be found on the official notice board.

7. Format

- 7.1 6 races are scheduled.
- 7.2 The event will consist of a series of races with all boats in the same class in the same fleet.

8. Venue and course

- 8.1 The races will be on inner or outer Motalaviken.
- 8.2 The course will be a windward-leeward course with an inner and outer loop as described in the sailing instructions.

9. Protests and penalties

- 9.1 RRS appendix P will apply.
- 9.2 RRS appendix T1 will apply.
- 9.3 In addition to penalties provided in RRS 64.2, the protest committee may penalize a boat in accordance with RRS 44.3c.

10. Scoring

- 10.1 RRS A5.3 will apply.
- 10.2 The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided by RRS 90.3e.
- 10.3 RRS A2.1 is changed so that with three or less races, no score will be excluded. After more than three races, one score will be excluded.
- 10.4 Three races are required to constitute a championship.

11. Prizes

11.1 Gold, silver and bronze plaques of the Nordic Sailing Federation will be awarded to the best three crews. Utility prizes will also be awarded.
