



Sailing Instructions Open Inofficial Swedish Championship H-Boat 8–10 of August 2025, Stockholm

1. RULES

- 1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2025–2028.
- 2. A boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance. The organizing authority cannot be held responsible for any events that occur because of actions or omissions by a competitor or a competing or participating boat, including insufficient insurance.
- 3. RRS 44.1 will be changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 4. RRS 60.1(a) will be changed so that a boat cannot protest another boat or competitor for a breach of NoR 1.2, 1.3, 1.5, 3.2, 6.3, 11 or 12. The penalty for breaking these rules may be less than disqualification if the protest committee so decides.
- 5. The H-Boat class rules apply with following exceptions. The total crew weight (in underwear) must not exceed 300 kg.
- 6. Personal flotation devices shall be worn at all times while afloat (RRS 40.1).
- 7. Advertising may be required in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.
- 8. Wind limits: Races will not start in more than 12 m/s stable wind.
- 9. 1.6 Each competitor shall comply with World Sailing Regulation 19 and be a valid member of a club or other organization affiliated to the Swedish Sailing Federation (SSF) or another World Sailing member national authority.
- 10. 1.7. Each competitor shall be a valid member of a National H-Boat Association affiliated to the International H-Boat Association (IHA)

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS & CHANGES TO SIS

- 2.1 Notices will be posted on the official notice board at Sailarena.
- 2.2 Changes to these SIs will be posted before 08:00 on the day they take effect, except

schedule changes which will be posted before 20:00 the day prior.

3. SCHEDULE

4. RACE AREA AND COURSE

- 4.1 The race area will be Lake Mälaren, preferably Riddarfjärden or Solviksfjärden.
- 4.2 Courses will be windward/leeward, described below but can be subject to changes. If so described in detail at the skippers' briefing.
- 4.3 The target time for the first finishing boat in each race will be 40 minutes, but possibly shorter as adjusted to the course.
- 4.4 Starting procedure according to RSS 26



5. SCORING AND PENALTIES

- 5.1 The event will consist of a series of races with all boats in the same fleet. Six races are scheduled. At least 3 races are required for a valid championship.
- 5.2 If fewer than 4 races are completed, all will count. If 4 or more, the worst score will be excluded.
- 5.3 A boat starting later than 10 minutes after her signal will be scored DNS.
- 5.4 A boat not finishing within 20 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored DNF.

5.5 Two-turns penalty replaced by one-turn penalty.

6. PROTESTS

- 6.1 Protests shall be filed within 60 minutes of the last boat finishing the last race of the day.
- 6.2 RRS Appendix T1 applies (Arbitration).

7. OTHER RULES

- 7.1 No haul-outs or hull cleaning during the event without prior written permission.
- 7.2 Diving equipment and plastic pools are not permitted during the regatta.
- 7.3 Crew changes only with written permission from the race committee.
- 7.4 All competitors participate at their own risk (RRS 3). The organizing authority accepts no liability.

8. PRIZES

8.1 Prizes will be awarded at the closing ceremony.
