The Organizing Authority is Varbergs Segelsällskap, in conjunction with the Swedish, Danish and Norwegian Finn classes.

Notice of Race

1. Organizing Authority and Venue

Organizing Authority and Venue The 2026 Finn DIF-DM, the Open Swedish Finn Class Championship and the Scandinavian Finn Cup will be held from August, Thursday 20 to Sunday 23. The Regatta Centre will be in Varbergs Segelsällskaps klubbhus, situated at Getterön Marina. The Regatta is part of the World Tour for Finns 2026.

2. Rules

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2025-2028 (RRS).
- 2.2 The IFA Class Rules will apply.
- 2.3 The rules for Danish Championships will apply.
- 2.4 The rules for Swedish Championships will apply
- 2.5 The Sailing Instructions may make permitted changes to any rules.
- 2.6 All competitors shall have personal flotation in accordance with RRS 1.2. Personal floatation shall be worn at all times on the water, unless certain circumstances make it necessary to undress.

2.7 Racing rule(s) will be changed as follows:

2.7.1 Rules 35, A4 and A5 will be changed to state, that boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing.

2.7.2 Rule 60.1 is changed so that boats cannot protest against specific parts in sailing instructions.

2.7.3 Rule 61.1(a) and 61.4(b) are changed, a boat cannot protest/request redress for specific parts in sailing instructions.

2.7.4 Rule A4 and A5.1 are changed, so boats, starting later than 4 minutes after start signal will be scored DNS, Did Not Start.

2.7.5 The sailing instructions may change other racing rules.

2.8 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

3. Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

4. Eligibility and Entry

4.1 Only competitors eligible in accordance with Finn Class Rules, who are current members of an IFA, recognized National Finn Association may compete. Danish nationals must be members of the Danish Finn Association and a club registered at Dansk Sejlunion to compete. Swedish competitors must be members of the Swedish Finn Association, a club registered at the Swedish Sailing Federation and have a valid competitors licence.

4.2 The Danish Champion (DM) title and medals are awarded in accordance with the rules for danish championship by Dansk Sejlunion

4.3 To be awarded the title Swedish Finn Class Champion (klassmästare) the competitor shall be a Swedish citizen.

4.4 **How to Register:**

Registration is completed by filling the online form at Sailarena.com + submitting full payment. The entry fee is 1.600 SEK if paid latest 1st of august. 1900 SEK if paid after that.

How to Pay:

An individual invoice will be sent out to the email address used in registration. The first round of invoices will be sent out apprx. June 1st with due date August 1st. Invoices are created manually so have some patient after registration.

If payment is not received on August 1st a reminder invoice with the higher fee will be sent out.

We would like to avoid but will offer possibility to pay at registration in Race Office.

Refund policy:

- If cancellation is made no later than August 1st or if the organizer rejects a boat's entry, the entry fee will be refunded.
- If cancellation is made after August 1st and is due to sudden injury or family emergencies 50% of the entry fee may be refunded.
Documentation will be requested.

4.5 Measurement certificate and valid certificate of insurance must be presented at registration.

4.6 The DFA Participant Solemn Declaration form must be filled out and signed as part of the registration and equipment inspection can be made.

5. Competition Format

5.1 The regatta will consist of scheduled 9 races.

6. Schedule:

6.1 No race will be started after 15.00 on the last day of racing.

6.2 In the event of any day's sailing being lost, an additional race may be scheduled for the following day(s) to enable the lost race(s) to be sailed. A maximum of 4 races per day will be sailed.

6.3 It is requested by the Nationally Finn Class and the organizers to attend the Opening and closing ceremonies.

7. Equipment Inspection

7.1 Boats will undergo random inspection of hulls, spars and sails as well as equipment checks according to the Finn Class Rules.

7.2 For the regatta one Boat, one mast, one boom, one rudder and two sails are allowed. Change of equipment due to damage must be approved by the Chairman of the technical committee.

7.3 All competitors shall hold a valid measurement certificate for their equipment used during the regatta.

7.4 Each boat shall have a tow rope, a minimum of 8 meters in length and of sufficient strength to tow several boats.

7.5 Boats will not be re-measured at any time during the Championship.

10. The Courses

The Courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

11. Penalty System

11.1 Appendix P will apply

11.2 Rule P2.3 will not apply and rule P2.2 is changed so it will apply to any penalty after the first one.

12. Scoring

12.1 Four (4) races for Danish sailors and three (3) races for Swedish sailors are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.3 (a) When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score

13. Support boats

Support boats shall be marked with National Letters and National flags.

Support boats shall register at the regatta office.

14. Radio Communications

Radio Communications is prohibited and the use of mobile telephones has to be in accordance with the Finn Class rules.

15. Prizes

15.1 The perpetual trophies will be awarded to the winners of the Danish National Championship.

15.2 The Organizing Authority will provide prizes for the 3 best overall winners.

15.3 Dansk Sejlunion Prizes (medals) Will be given to the best three (3) Danish boats.

15.4 There will be awarded a "Danish Veteran Trophy" to the best participant over 60 years.

16. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority and the National Finn Associations will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

18. Doping Control

For the purposes of doping control (in-competition testing), the ISAF Anti-doping Code (ISAF regulation 21) will apply.

19. Rights to use name and likeness.

If the competitor at registration has signed a media right form, the competitor grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

20. Changes to the Notice of Race
