1. Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 (RRS) and with appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions.

1.2 Swedish competitors shall when racing follow the licensing rules for advertising as decided by the Swedish Sailing Federation.

1.3 Competitors shall, when afloat wear personal flotation devices. This rule does not apply to short-term replacement or adjustment of clothing or personal equipment, or when competitors are in the harbor or under deck. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. This changes RRS 40. A boat that breaks this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee (DP).

1.4 The class rules for J/24 will apply.

2. Eligibility requirements

2.1 The competitor that is in charge on board the boat shall be a member of his/her Member National Authority or one of its affiliated organizations.

2.2 The competitor that is in charge on board shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This regulation applies from the year the competitor reaches the age of 12. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation.

2.3 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance that covers a claim of damages for at least 5 million SEK.

2.4 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

2.5 All Swedish Crew members shall be members of the Swedish J 24 Class Association.

2.6 A competitor must be at least 12 years old the year the competition is conducted. 2.6 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the competition.

The fee includes regatta, launching and hauling boats, mooring, parking trailers, parking of cars and recreational vehicles, barbeque on Friday, regatta party on Saturday (drinks not included), After Sail at the Prize giving ceremony, prizes, sanction fee SSF (100 SEK).

3.4 Late entry will be accepted according to the following conditions: An extra fee of 600 SEK will be charged for late entry or payment received after 20 July 2025.

4. Registration and measurement checks

4.1 Registrations of all crew members shall be made at the race office at Malmö Segel Sällskaps Office not later than 15.00 on 8 of august 2025.

4.2 Measurement certificates shall be presented at the registration. All sails must be measured and stamped by an authorized measurer.

4.3 The competitor that is in charge onboard, according to § 2.2 shall be able to present a valid Swedish license for competitor.

4.4 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, the race- or/and the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection.

4.5 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

4.6 A competitor who has been ill or injured may be replaced after approval of the race committee. However, the person in charge may not be changed.

4.7 The Competitor in charge on board shall be able to prove club membership.

4.8 Boats may be inspected randomly regarding safety equipment.

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, 2025-2028, Standard Sailing Instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the clubhouse and online <https://www.sailarena.com/sv/se/club/mss/sm-j24-2025>

10:00 Warning signal for the first race of the day. 4 races scheduled. Saturday Evening 19:00: Dinner and Party at the club house.

Sunday August 10

10:00 Warning signal for the first race of the day. 2 races scheduled.

No warning signal later than 13:30

Sunday afternoon: Prize giving ceremony and After Sail.

Price giving as soon as after races finish. There will be time to lift the boats before price giving

7. Format

7.1 8 races are scheduled

8.1 Venue and course

The racing areas will be just outside Limhamns småbåtshamn. Very short distance.

8.2 Windward-leeward course, with offset buoy and gate will be sailed. Approximately 60 minutes per race

9. Protests and penalty systems

9.1 RRS 44.1 will be changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required for a boat that may have broken a rule in RRS part 2

10. Scoring

10.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A, 2025-2028, will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores and in the case of more than three completed races, the worst score will be excluded.

10.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

11. Prizes

11.1 There will be prizes for the top 3 boats. Perpetual trophy for best Swedish youth boat, all under 25 years. Perpetual trophy for Swedish Champion. Perpetual trophy to the best non-Swedish crew will be given.

11.2 Swedish Sailing Federation's prizes are awarded according to "SSF:s Tävlingsreglemente 2025", chapter 5.2 Championship for Swedish crews.

11.3 The winner of the Swedish championship is invited to the Swedish competition "Seglingens Mästare" according to the rules for this event. Entry to "Seglingens Mästare" must be made latest 14 days after the completion of this Championship.
