

Notice of Race (NoR)

GKSS Foil Weekend 2023 Swedish Moth Championship Waszp Class Championship

Dates: September 16th - 17th

Location: Långedrag, Sweden

Boatclasses: International Moth Class Open, Waszp Open

Organizing authority: Royal Gotheburg Yacht Clubb, GKSS

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Class Rules will apply except for any that are altered by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions. The internet links to the class rules are: http://www.moth-sailing.org/wp-content/uploads/2017/05/MTH2017CR010517.pdf

- 1.3 All boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 1.4 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.
- 1.5 When the water temperature is below +14°C a competitor shall wear clothes that prevents from hypothermia, i.e. wetsuit or drysuit.

2. Eligibility

2.1 All boats competing shall have a third party liability insurance.

- 2.2 The event is open class and the person in charge shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority.
- 2.3 Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. The person in charge, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 2.4 A VHF may be carried onboard during racing for communication with the race committee.
- 2.5 A competitor shall be at least twelve years old the same year this event takes place.
- 2.6 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the competition.

3. Entry

- 3.1 Boats may enter the event by registrering online at Sailarena GKSS Foil Weekend (sailarena.com) not later than September 9th.
- 3.2 The entry fee is 1000 SEK of which 300 SEK is a fee to Swedish Moth Class Association. The fee is payed in Sailarena when making the entry. If the entry is withdrawn not later than September 9, or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee will be refunded with a deduction for administration cost of 150 SEK.
- 3.3 Late entry is possible in Sailarena but not later than September 15 with an extra fee of 200 SEK.

4. Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registration should be made in Sailarena not later than September 15, at 4:00 pm.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership, competition license and valid measurement certificate or similar.
- 4.3. A boat is not allowed to change its crew during the regatta.
- 4.4 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.
- 4.5 A boat shall not change its rudder or dagger board or the T-foils on them whilst afloat. The change may only be made in the launching area. A boat wishing to change foils shall sail to the launching area and back without help. In case of breakage, assistance

to get to and from the launching area is allowed. It is also allowed to get replacement equipment brought from the boat park or launching area.

4.6 It is only allowed to use 2 sets of the following equipment during the regatta: Sail, mast, boom, rudder with foil, daggerboard with foil. In case of breakage, it is allowed to replace broken equipment.

5. Sailing instructions and information

5.1 Sailing instructions and other official information will be available on the official notice board at Sailarena <u>GKSS Foil Weekend 2023</u> (sailarena.com) not later than Thursday, the 14th of September.

6. Schedule


6.2 On Sunday the 17th September there will be no warning signal after 16:00.

7. Format

7.1 Up to 16 races are scheduled.

8. Venue and course

8.1 The regatta will be held at the water outside Royal Gothenburg Yacht Club in Långedrag, Sweden.



8.2 The course will be a winward/leeward course as described in the sailing instructions.

9. Protests and penalties

- 9.1 RRS appendix P will apply
- 9.2 RRS appendix T1 will apply.
- 9.3 RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by a One-Turn penalty.

10. Scoring

- 10.1 RRS A2.1 is changed so that:
 - With 3 or less races, no (0) score will be excluded.
 - With 4 to 7 races, the (1) worst score will be excluded.
 - With 8 to 11 races, the two (2) worst scores will be excluded.
 - With 12 to 16 races, the three (3) worst scores will be excluded.
- 10.2 Three races are required to constitute a championship.
- 10.3 Swedish National Championship (Svenskt Mästerskap) classification is only applicable for boats with a skipper that is a Swedish citizen.

11. Prizes

11.1 1 to 3 three prizes will be awarded in each class.
