



# Supplementary Sailing Instructions

## Swedish International Moth Championship GKSS Skiffregatta Waszp

**Dates:** 2023, September 15<sup>th</sup> -17<sup>th</sup>

**Location:** GKSS, Gothenburg

**Boat classes:** : International Moth Open, Waszp Open

### 1. Race office and Signal pole

- 1.1 Race office is located in GKSS club house.
- 1.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag pole marked with an orange flag next to the berthing ramp.
- 1.3 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in RRS Race Signals.
- 1.4 Flag D displayed on the flag pole together with one sound signal means the boats are allowed to leave the harbour. If flag D is not displayed, the boats shall stay ashore.

### 2. Schedule

- 2.1 Friday, September 15
  - 15:00 The Regatta Office opens
  - 18:00 Tune-up Race (4 races)

The course for the tune-up race will be a Grand Prix course, which is described in Appendix A of this Sailing Instruction

Saturday, September 16

- 08:30 Skippers meeting
- 10:00 Warning signal for the first race of the day  
After Sail

Sunday, September 17

- 10:00 Warning signal for the first race of the day  
Prizegiving ASAP after racing

- 2.2 No warning signal will be made after 16:00 on Sunday the 17<sup>th</sup>.

### 3 Marks

- 3.1 The gate marks 1A and 1B are red cones.  
The gate marks 2A and 2B are yellow cylinders.
- 3.2 Upon a change of a leg, the the first mark will be moved to its new position (see SI 6.6 for procedure). This changes App S10.1

### 4 Course

- 4.1 The Course (see sketch below) to be sailed, if no course identification flag is shown:

Moth Open:

START – 1A/1B (Gate) – 2A/2B (Gate) – 1A/1B (Gate) – FINISH.

Wazp Open:

START – 1A/1B (Gate) – FINISH.

This changes App S5.1.


- 4.2 If, Flag T (RED/WHITE/BLOCK) is displayed, no later than together with the Warning signal an extra lap is added. The Course shall then be sailed:

Moth Open:

START – 1A/1B (Gate) – 2A/2B (Gate) – 1A/1B (Gate) – 2A/2B (Gate) – 1A/1B (Gate) – FINISH.

Wazp Open:

START – 1A/1B (Gate) – 2A/2B (Gate) – 1A/1B (Gate) – FINISH.





## 5 Time limits

- 5.1 The race time limit is 30 minutes for the first boat in each class to finish.
- 5.2 The finishing window is 10 minutes, after the first boat that starts, sails the course and finishes for each class.

## 6. Changes and additions to appendix S

- 6.1 To alert boats that a new starting sequence is about to begin, the orange flag on the starting line will be displayed with a sound signal not less than two minutes before the warning signal. This changes Appendix S 5.2.
- 6.2 The races shall be started following a three minutes starting procedure as described in the table below. This changes Appendix S 9.1 and RRS 26.

<i>Minutes before starting signal</i>	<i>Visual signal</i>	<i>Sound signal</i>	<i>Means</i>
3	Class flag	One	Warning signal
2	P, I, U, black flag	One	Preparatory signal
1	Preparatory flag removed	One long	One minute
0	Class flag removed	One	Start signal

- 6.3 The class flags will be:  
Flag E (Blue and Red) for Moth Open.  
Flag F (White field with Red diamond) for Waszp Open.  
This changes Appendix S 6.1
- 6.4 The start line and the finish line will be between the staffs displaying orange flags on the Race Committee vessel (RC) and the port/leeward end boat. This changes App S9.2 and App S11.1.  
The start line shall be crossed in a windward direction.  
The finish line shall be crossed in a down wind direction.
- 6.5 A boat that does not start within five minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS) without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2
- 6.6 RRS 33 is changed to:  
While boats are racing, the race committee may change a leg of the course by moving an existing mark. Signal flag C together with repetitive sounds is a sufficient signal when changing position of the new mark. This changes RRS 33.
- 6.7 RRS appendix P will apply.
- 6.8 RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by a One-Turn penalty.
- 6.9 RRS appendix T1 will apply.

## Appendix A Description of the Grand Prix tune-up course for September the 15<sup>th</sup>

### Marks

The start line and the finish line will be between the staffs displaying orange flags on the Race Commite vessel (RC) and the port/leeward end boat.

The Reach Mark will be a red conical mark.

The leeward gate 1A/1B will be yellow cylindrical marks.

The windward gate 2A/2B will be yellow cylindrical marks.

### Course

The Course (see sketch below) shall be sailed:

Moth open: START – R (Reach Mark) – 1A/1B (Leeward Gate) – 2A/2B (Windward Gate) – 1A/1B (Leeward Gate) – 2A/2B (Windward Gate) - R (Reach Mark) – FINISH

Waszp open: START – R (Reach Mark) – 1A/1B (Leeward Gate) – 2A/2B (Windward Gate) – R (Reach Mark) – FINISH
