



Notice of Race (NoR)

Event:	Swedish Championship for Dragon
Date:	6 th – 8 th August 2021
Location:	Marstrand - Sweden
Level of competition:	RED
Boatclass:	DRAGON
Organizer:	Marstrands Segelsällskap (MaSS)

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. Rules

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*

1.2 International Dragon Association (IDA) Class rules will apply.

1.3 [NP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

1.4 RRS 40.1 applies at all times a boat is on the water, but it does not apply to a keelboat when the boat is moored or when the competitor is under deck. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices.

A boat that violates this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee(DP).

1.5 The competitor that is in charge on board shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This regulation applies from the year the competitor reach the age of 12. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation

1.6 It is mandatory to use VHF. The race committee will inform every start sequence or other information on channel 72*.

* Channel may be changed at skippers briefing

2. Eligibility requirements

2.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance



- 2.2 The competitor that is in charge on board the boat shall be a member of his/her Member National Authority or one of its affiliated organisations.
- 2.3 The competitor who is responsible on board, is a Swedish citizen or has resided in Sweden for at least six of the last twelve months before the regatta is carried out and turns at least 12 years old in the year the competition is carried out, must have a competition license issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation.
- 2.4 If less than 15 participants, the organization reserves the right to cancel the regatta

3. Entry

- 3.1 Entry and payment shall be made **not later** than 30th June and sent to www.sailarena.se see 3.3 or as described in 3.4.
- The entry fee is 3 500 SEK until 30th June.
 - Late entry fee is 4 500 SEK after 30th June until 1st August i
- 3.2 The entry fee includes:
- On Thursday Opening Ceremony with dinner
 - On Friday and Saturday After-Sail
 - Launching, retrieving and docking
 - Trailer and car parking at designated place
 - Fee to the Swedish Sailing Sailing Federation with 100 SEK
 - MaSS costs for the sailing event
- 3.3 The Entry shall include the following:

- 3.4 If there are problems for non-Swedish participants to enter via www.sailarena.se you can transfer the entry fee to the account of (MaSS)

You must in this case notify the organization your entry (according to 3.2) by mail to race@marstrandsss.se

- 3.5 The whole entry fee will be paid back if cancellation is made before the closing date 30th June.
- 3.6 The entire entry fee will be refunded if the championship is cancelled due to too few participants – see point 2.4

4. Registration and measurement checks

- 4.1 Registration of all crew must be done in Sailarena not later than Friday 6th August 09.30 hours
- 4.2 The person in charge on board must be able to prove club membership, any competition license and the boat's measurement certificate or equivalent.
- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, the race- or/and the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection.
- 4.4 Random measurement or secure checks may be done.
- 4.4 A competitor who has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the racing committee but not the person who is in charge on board .
- 4.5 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

5. Sailing instructions and information

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions and other official information will be available on the official noticeboard on www.sailarena.se and also on the official noticeboard located outside Strandverket.



5.2 The Racing Committee will, when possible and appropriate, send information about the course, start times, safety, etc. on VHF channel 72 or channel communicated at skippers briefing.

7. Race format

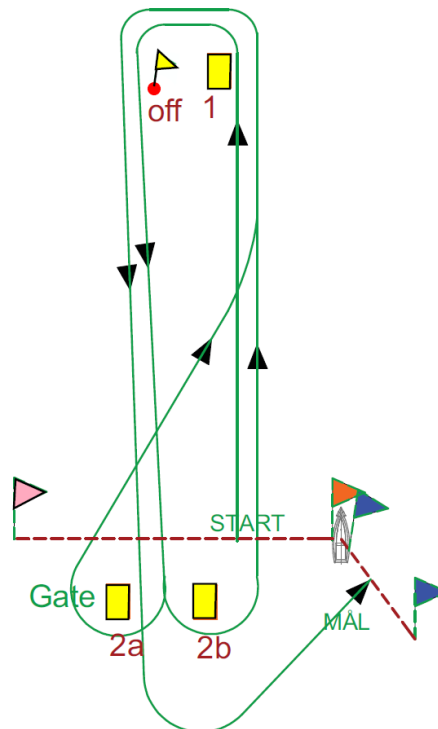
7.1 The regatta will be implemented as fleet racing in a straight series.

8. Racing area

8.1 The racing areas will be on the Marstrand fiord (west of the Marstrand island)

9. The course

9.1 Windward-leeward will be sailed according to the sketch below.



9.2 The regatta committee grants them self their right to change the design of the course and the number of loops.

11. Protests and penalty systems

11.1 Amending RRS § 44.1 and § 44.2 changes the two-turn penalty to one-turn penalty.

11.2 RRS appendix T will apply

12. Scoring

12.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed; a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

12.2 RRS rule A5.3 will apply.

12.2 With change of the rule RRS 90.3e the Racing Committee does not make any changes to the results 12 hours after the last race in accordance with the conditions set out in RRS 90.3e.

10.3 RRS A2.1 is changed so that in the case of three or fewer completed races, all are counted and in the case of more than three completed races, the worst may be counted out.



10.4 A minimum of 3 races must be completed to constitute a Swedish Championship

11. Prizes

11.1 Championship plaquettes from Riksidrottsförbundet in gold, silver and bronze and titles may be awarded if six or more boats from at least three different Swedish clubs located in more than one Swedish district have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.

11.2 MaSS prizes to 20 % of the participants

11.3 Possible sponsor prizes

11.4 Prizes from the Swedish Dragon Association

11.5 The winner of the Swedish championship is invited to the competition Sailing Champion according to the conditions stated in that competition's invitation. Registration for the Sailing Champion must be made in Sailarena no later than 14 days after the Swedish championship has been completed.
