Notice of Race

Date: 31/5-2/6, 2024
Place: Askersunds small boat harbour, see map page 4
Boats: Supplied 11:metre OD
Organizer: ASMK in cooperation with the Swedish Class Association 11:metre OD

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 All boats, with sails and equipment are provided by the organizer. The format is sprint with 11:metre OD boats. The Class Rule do not apply.
Rules for boat handling according to Appendix C.
- 1.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Part 1, #3 Decision to Race. The organizer does not accept any responsibility for property or personal injury that someone has suffered in connection with or before, during or after the regatta.
- 1.4 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. However, it does not apply on a keelboat when it is moored or when the competitor is below deck.
Each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device except when changing or adjusting clothes or personal equipment. Wet suites and dry suites are not personal flotation devices.
- 1.5 The number of teams may be limited. The organizer have a ranking list for this purpose. Teams that participate in the Scandinavian Tour 2024 have priority. The organizer can also give wild-cards. More info at:

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 The skipper of each team shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or his/her national authority.
- 2.2 A team is at least 3 competitors and maximum 4 competitors are in the boat when racing. A team can have substitutes.
- 2.3 All teams shall be prepared to act as officials so that the regatta can be carried out in the best way.
- 2.4 Provided boats are insured by the organizer.
A team that cause damage to the boat, rig, sails or equipment are liable for compensation for the damage up to a maximum amount of SEK 5,000 per instance of damage. In the event of damage exceeding SEK 5,000 compensation is settled via the boats insurance.
- 2.5 The skipper shall be at least 18 years old this year 2024.
- 2.6 The skipper shall submit a written declaration at registration.

3. Entry

- 3.1 An account in sailarena is required in order to enter. [Register an account in sailarena](#)
- 3.2 Interest in participation shall be made as soon as possible to bjorn.t.sterner@gmail.com
Final notification shall be made at the latest 2024-05-24 via [sailarena](#).
- 3.3 The entry fee is SEK 4,000 and shall be paid by credit card via [sailarena](#).
- 3.4 The entry fee includes Before Sail/After Sail in the club house, 2 lunches and regatta dinner for 4 team members.
If the team has more than 4 members, they can enter by paying an additional SEK 1,000 per member.
- 3.5 An entry is complete when the entry fee is registred at [sailarena](#).

4. Registration

- 4.1 Registration shall be made at the race office at the latest 2024-06-01, 09.00.
- 4.2 A team member may not be exchanged without the permission of the Race Committee.

7. Format

- 7.1 The regatta is a sprint event, meaning many short races, Flights, where 3 boats race in each Flight. A number of Flights will constitute a basic round. The 3 best after the basic rounds will go to a final.
- 7.2 Each team is designated at team-letter A, B, C ... and race according to the Race Schedule in Appendix B. The Race Schedule will be handed out at the Skippers meeting and published at the official notice board.
- 7.3 The Race committee can change the format and the Race Schedule at any time.
- 7.4 The boats have modified rigs. The running backstays and checkstays are removed. One Jib, one main and a spinnaker will be used. It is not allowed to adjust the standing rigging.
- 7.5 The boats will be available for training Friday 31/5, 17.00-20.00

8. Venue and Course

- 8.1 The race area is on the lake Alsen in Askersund.
- 8.2 The course is a windward-leeward course.

9. Protests and penalties

- 9.1 RRS Appendix T will apply.
- 9.2 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the 2-turns Penalty is replaced by the 1-turn Penalty.

10. Scoring

- 10.1 1:st in a Flight gives 3 p. 2:nd gives 2 p. 3:rd gives 1 p. DNF gives 0 p.

11. Prizes

- 11.1 Prizes to the first 3 teams.

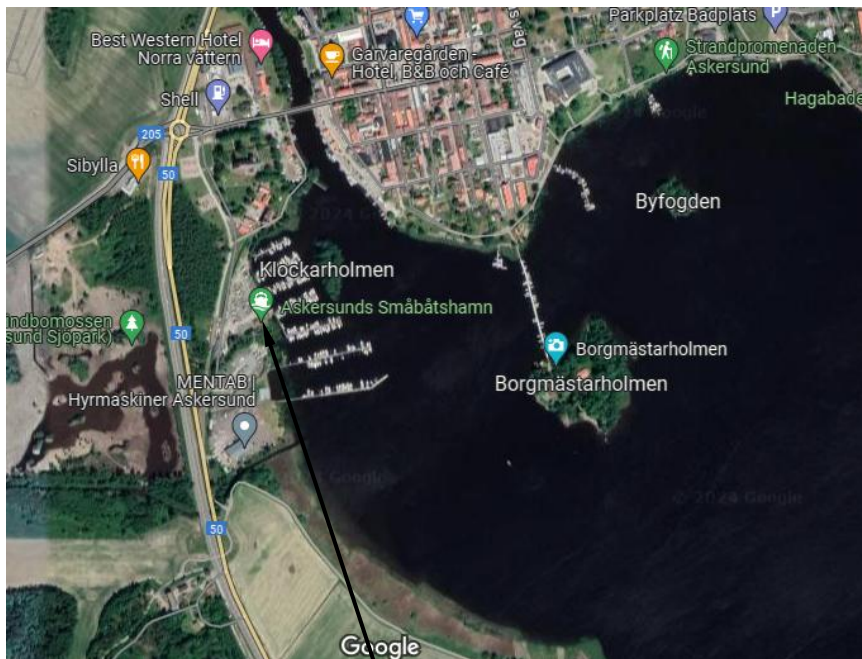
