



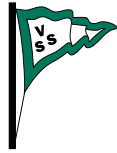

# NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 *Rules for Nordic Championships*, available at [nordicsailing.org/explorer/files/Nordic%20Championships%20Rules\\_%20Final%202026\\_04\\_24.pdf](https://nordicsailing.org/explorer/files/Nordic%20Championships%20Rules_%20Final%202026_04_24.pdf), applies.
- 1.3 The Swedish Sailing Federation prescriptions, available at [svensksegling.se/om-oss/dokumentbanken/1188-swedish-sailing-federation-prescription-texts-2025-2028-2026-02-03.pdf](https://svensksegling.se/om-oss/dokumentbanken/1188-swedish-sailing-federation-prescription-texts-2025-2028-2026-02-03.pdf), apply.
- 1.4 [DP] RRS 40.1 applies at all times afloat, however, it does not apply for a boat that is made fast or moored.
- 1.5 When the water temperature is below +14°C a competitor shall wear clothes that prevents from hypothermia, e.g., wetsuit or drysuit.
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages in documents issued by the organizing authority or committees, the English text takes precedence.

### 2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at the official notice board after 1800 hrs., 21 August 2026.

### 3 COMMUNICATION

On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the sailing instructions.

### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the 2.4mR class and is contested in open division.
- 4.2 Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of their national authority.
- 4.3 Every competitor, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competition license (tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 4.4 A competitor shall be at least thirteen years old the year the event takes place (born 2013 or later).
- 4.5 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the competition.
- 4.6 Substitution of competitors is not allowed.
- 4.7 Boats may enter by registering in Sailarena and paying the entry fee no later than 20 August 2026.
- 4.8 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

4.9 The organizing authority will cancel the event if eight entries have not been reached by 12 August 2026.

**5 FEES**

5.1 Entry fees are as follows:

	Dates	SEK
Entry	until 12 August	1,000
Late entry	13–20 August	1,300

5.2 The entry fee includes:

- launching and haul-out,
- berthing fees during the event,
- after-sail on Saturday, and
- prizes.

5.3 If cancellation is made no later than 12 August 2026 or if the organizing authority rejects a boat's entry because the event has been cancelled or according to RRS 76.1, the entry fee will be refunded, if for the former with a reduction of 100 SEK for administrative costs.

**6 SCHEDULE**

6.1 Registration, including event equipment inspection:

Date	Location
21 August, 1800–2000 hrs.	Club house
22 August, 0845–0930 hrs.	

At registration, the crew shall upon request be able to verify relevant memberships.

6.2 Racing days are 22–23 August.

6.3 A total of seven races are scheduled.

6.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1055 hrs., 22 August.

6.5 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1500 hrs.

6.6 A competitor meeting will be held at 22 August, 0945 hrs., outside the club house.

**7 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION**

7.1 Each boat shall produce or verify the existence of a valid measurement certificate.

7.2 [DP] A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the rules.

7.3 [DP] When instructed by a race official on the water, a boat shall proceed to a designated area for inspection

**8 VENUE**

8.1 NoR addendum 'Map of Hundudden' shows the plan of the event venue.

8.2 NoR addendum 'Racing Area' shows the location of the racing area.

**9 COURSES**

The courses will be windward/leeward.

**10 PENALTY SYSTEM**

10.1 RRS 31 is replaced by: "While racing, neither the crew nor any part of a boat's hull shall touch a starting mark before starting, a mark that begins, bounds or ends the leg of the course on which she is sailing, or a finishing mark after finishing. In addition, while racing, a boat shall not touch a race committee vessel that is also a mark."

10.2 In RRS 60.2(a)(1), the first sentence is replaced by "If the protestor is a boat, she shall hail 'Protest' and conspicuously display a red flag, at the first reasonable opportunity for each. "

10.3 Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, applies.

10.4 RRS 44.1 and P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10.5 Appendix T, Arbitration, applies.

**11 SCORING**

11.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

11.2 RRS A2.1 is changed so that:

11.2.1 when fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11.2.2 when four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11.3 RRS 90.3(e) applies.

**12 [DP] BERTHING**

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the harbour as outlined in the sailing instructions.

**13 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured so that the person in charge is covered for

liability claims of minimum 5,000,000 SEK per incident or the equivalent.

## **14 PRIZES**

**14.1** Prize giving will be held as soon as possible after the racing has finished.

**14.2** Nordic Sailing Federation plaques will be awarded to the three best crews.

**14.3** One VSS prize per five entries will be awarded.

## addendum: Other Information

The VSS harbour and yard Hundudden is situated on the eastern mouth of Djurgårdskanalen and near Kaknästornet. On the venue, there is a club house, a café, and a pillar jib crane. In the club house, there are toilets and showers.

The code for the road barrier into the club area and the club house will be sent to competitors in the week before the event.

### Launching and haul-out

On the venue, there is a pillar jib crane to be used for launching and haul-out of competing boats from their own trailer and with own lifting straps Friday–Sunday. Driving instructions for the VSS area can be found in NoR addendum 'Map of Hundudden'.

If you wish to launch at another time, please contact Alexander Bratt ([kappsegling@vss.nu](mailto:kappsegling@vss.nu) // 070-289 46 08) for an agreement. The crane is inaccessible when VSS youth activities are in progress, Wednesday and Thursday, 1700–2030 hrs.

### Mooring

Competing boats shall moor in the VSS harbour as outlined in the sailing instructions. If there is a large number entries some boats may need to be hauled-out between race days. Boats may be moored in the water in VSS harbour Thursday–Monday.

### Parking

The VSS harbour can be reached by car via Hunduddsvägen from Kaknästornet. Cars may park on the VSS gravel area.

### Public transport to Hundudden

By public transport, Hundudden can be reached with the following stops and a short walk:

### Café

Adjacent to the VSS club house, there is Kafé Kruthuset, which has light refreshments for sale, open 10–17 daily.

### Grilling

If desired, a grill can be provided.

### Accommodation

RVs can be parked on the VSS gravel area.

Accommodation is also possible on the upper floor of the VSS club house with own sleeping pads. The room cannot be locked daytime. The room is not handicap-friendly. Contact Alexander Bratt (see above).
