





# Notice of Race (NoR)

# Swedish Championship for the 505 Class Euro 505 Cup 4 SWE 505 CUP 3

Dates: August 04-06, 2023

Boatclass: International 505 Class

**Organizing authority:** Varbergs Segelsällskap (Varberg Yacht Club), in conjunction with the Swedish 505 Association

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The international 505 classrules
- 1.3 All boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. (DP)
- 1.4 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. However, it does not apply on a keelboat when it is moored or when the competitor is below deck. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the Protest Committee. (DP)
- 1.5 If there is a discrepancy between Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will prevail.

- 1.6 By entering the regatta, competitors give the right to the organizing authority, its sponsors and the Swedish 505 Association, in perpetuity, to use and show, from time to time at its discretion, any films, photos or other images of the competitors from the regatta without compensation.
- 1.7 To be awarded the title Swedish Champion both helmsman and crew have to be Swedish citizens.

# 2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All boats competing shall have a third-party liability insurance.
- 2.2 The event is an open class championship.
- 2.3 Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. For Swedish competitors the person in charge shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 2.4 A competitor shall be at least twelve years old the year the event takes place.
- 2.5 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the competition.

### 3. Entry

- 3.1 Boats may enter the event by register helmsman and crew online at Sailarena:

  not later than July 17, or with the late entry fee (see 3.2) not later than August 03, 19.00.
- 3.2 The early entry fee is SEK 1500 and has to be paid July 17 the latest. The late entry fee is SEK 2000 and has to be paid August 03 the latest.

# 4. Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registration shall also be made at arrival at the Race Office.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership, competition license and valid measurement certificate or similar.
- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.
- 4.4 A competitor that has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the race committee. However, the person in charge shall not be replaced.

# 5. Sailing instructions and information

5.1 Sailing instructions and other official information will be available on the official notice board at the Race Office. As a service to the competitors official information will be posted at Sailarena as well.

## 7. Format

- 7.1 11 (4+4+3) races are scheduled.
- 7.2 The event will consist of a series of races with all boats in the same fleet.
- 7.3 Gate start will be used. Subject to change by Race Committee.

#### 8. Venue and course

- 8.1 The course will be set SW to W of the harbour. Two race areas might be used.
- 8.2 The course will be a windward/leeward course as described in the sailing instructions.

## 9. Protests and penalties

- 9.1 RRS appendix P will apply.
- 9.2 RRS appendix T will apply.

# 10. Scoring

- 10.1 RRS A5.2 will apply.
- 10.2 RRS A2.1 is changed so that with three or less races, no score will be excluded. After more than three races one score will be excluded. If nine races have been completed two scores will be excluded.
- 10.3 Three races are required to constitute a championship.

## 11. Prizes

- 11.1 Gold, silver and bronze plaques for the Swedish Championship will be awarded to the three best crews who are Swedish citizens.
- 11.2 The Swedish 505 Association's trophy 'Hornet' is awarded to the Swedish Champion.
- 11.3 The Swedish 505 Association's trophy 'Classic' is awarded to the crew who are the best classic team who are Swedish citizens. Classic boats are number 8554 or lower/older.
- 11.4 Prizes might be awarded to the best junior team, the best mixed team and the best women team.

#### Accommodation

Varberg is a holiday resort and many people come here in the summer to enjoy the beaches, nature, cosy athmosphere and so on. Therefore it is very important to book accommodation early, so please do so if you will take part in the event.

This place is a 10 to 15 minutes walk from the club.
