Notice of Race (NoR)

2024 Swedish Championship Nordic Folkboat

Dates: August 14-18

Location: Lake Vättern, Karlsborg Sweden

Boatclass: Nordic Folkboat

Organizing authority: Carlsborgs sailing association (CSS)

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Nordic Folkboat International Class Rules 2021-2024 will apply. The current version can be found on www.folkboat.com.
- 1.3 All boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 1.4 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. However, it does not apply on a keelboat when it is moored or when the competitor is below deck. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All boats competing shall be insured so that the person in charge is covered for liability claims up to at least 5 million Swedish kronor.
- 2.2 The event is open class
- 2.3 Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. A person in charge, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competition license issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.

In the Nordic Folkboat class, the person in charge on board shall be a valid member of a National Nordic Folkboat Association affiliated to the Nordic Folkboat International Association (NFIA).

- 2.4 A competitor shall be at least twelve years old the year the event takes place.
- 2.5 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the competition.

3. Entry

- 3.1 Boats may enter the event by registering online at Sailarena SM Folkbåt 2024 Sailarena not later than 16 of July at 6:00 pm CET
- 3.2 The entry fee is 3000 SEK to be paid thru BG 5823 0814 or by Swish 123 050 66 75 when making the entry (Swedish participants only)

The payment shall be marked "SKIPPERS'S NAME" and "SAIL NO". If the entry is withdrawn not later than 21 days before the event, or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee will be refunded. Late registration fee + 900SEK will be possible to the 24:th of July at 6:00 pm CET.

- 3.3 For the international participants it possible to pay the fees by card in the ticket machine at the race office during the registration the 14:th of August.
- 3.4 The entry fee includes.
 - Boat lift fees
 - Car and trailer parking
 - Mooring fees during the regatta
 - After Sails (excl. beverage)
 - Opening Ceremony (excl. beverage)
 - Regatta dinner (excl. beverage)
- 3:5 Due to Swedish legislation, no beverages are allowed to be brought. Wine, beer, and other beverages will be available at the club bar.

4. Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registration of the whole crew should be made at the race office latest the 14:th of August at 7:00 pm CET.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership, competition license and valid measurement certificate including sails (2+2) NFIA numbers and boat or similar.
- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.
- 4.4 A competitor that has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the race committee. However, the person in charge may not be changed.
- 4.5 The following documents should be signed of in the helmsman's declaration form (will be posted on sail arena) and shall be handover at the Race Office

Helmsman's declaration, a validation that all the following documents are up to date.

- (a) Valid measurement certificate.
- (b) Documents indicating valid memberships and license according to NoR 4.1 and 4.2.
- (c) A complete crew list with name, contact information, club and nationality, including name and phone number of contact person, for each crew member
- (d) Contact phone number ashore during the regatta.
- (e) a signed helmsman's declaration form

5. Sailing instructions and information

- 5.1 Sailing instructions and other official information will be available on the official notice board at Sail Arena SM Folkbåt 2024 Sailarena
- 5.2 The race committee will when possible and appropriate broadcast information regarding the course, starting times, safety etc. on VHF 72

6. Schedule

7. Format

- 7.1 Up to 9 races are scheduled.
- 7.2 The event will consist of a series of races with all boats in the same class in the same fleet.

8. Venue and course

- 8.1 Lake Vättern, in the area outside the lighthouse
- 8.2 The course will be a windward/leeward course as described in the sailing instructions.

9. Protests and penalties

- 9.2 RRS appendix T1will apply.
- 9.3 RRS 44.1 will be changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty

10. Scoring

- 10.2 The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided for in RRS 90.3e.
- 10.3 RRS A2.1 is changed so that with three or less races, no score will be excluded. After more than three races one score will be excluded.
- 10.4 Three races are required to constitute a championship.

11. TROPHIES AND PRIZES

11.1 The Swedish Sports Confederation's Championship Rules and SSF's Competition Regulations 2024 will apply for the award of championship titles and championship signs. These rules and regulations state, among other things, that a competitor to obtain the title of Swedish Champion must be a Swedish citizen. 13.2 Challenge trophies and the organizer's prizes will be given. 13.3 Championship signs, trophies and prizes will be awarded at the Closing Ceremony and all competitors are expected to participate in that ceremony. Prizes not claimed at the Closing Ceremony will remain with the organizing authority.

12. PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

12.1 By entering or participating in the regatta, competitors accept that they may be photographed and videotaped participating in the races or visiting the regatta venue and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication, and republication of such images in any media, combined with the competitor's name or not, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.
