

Supplementary Sailings Instructions

SWEDISH CHAMPIONSHIP FOR DRAGON

August 22nd – 23rd 2020

1. Time schedule

1.1 Dates of racing

On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15.00

- 1.2 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.
- 1.3 3 6 races with 4 groups in every race are scheduled during the first day of the regatta.
- 1.4 Once Saturday racing is finished, boats with low score will sail in GOLD fleet, boats with high score will sail in SILVER fleet. The two fleets will be divided equal.
- 1.5 3 races are scheduled on Sunday.
- 1.6 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- 1.7 Target time for one race is 40 minutes.





2. Location of the race office, flagpole, and official Notice Board

- 2.1 The race office is located at MaSS facilities at Södra Strandverket on the Marstrand Island
- 2.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed at flagpole at the end of the pier from Strandverket.

3. Notices to competitors

3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board.

4. Changes to sailing instructions

- 4.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board before 08.00 on the day it will take effect.
- 4.2 Any change to the time schedule will be posted on the official notice board before 18.00 on the day before it will take effect.

5. Signals made ashore

5.1 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 60 minutes'.

6. Marks

- 6.1 The rounding marks are yellow buoys.
- 6.2 Rounding marks when changing the course are yellow buoys
- 6.3 The starting line is between an orange flag on the Committee Boat and an orange spar buoy.
- 6.4 The finish line is between a blue flag on the Committee Boat and a blue spar buoy.
- 6.5 When changing the course, new marks will be yellow.

7. Time limits

- 7.1 Race Time Limit
 Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 80 minutes.
- 7.2 Finishing Window Finishing window is 20 minutes.





8. The course

- 8.1 The course is a trapezoid course with inner and outer loop as shown in the attachment. **See attachment 1 & 2.** Each rounding- mark to be left to port.
- An alternative course can be used in case of heavy weather. The race area will be between Ärholmen and Marstrand Island. The alternative course will be announced at competitors briefing. **See attachment 3.**
- 8.3 Competitors on Saturday are divided in 4 groups e.g. YELLOW, GREEN, BLUE, RED. We will use the letters Y, G, B, R to define the colors
- 8.4 Groups, colors and sailing order for Saturday

- 8.5 Gold fleet have a yellow class flag. Silver fleet have a blue class flag. The course for each fleet will be signaled with numeral pennants. Numeral pennant one outer loop. Numeral pennant two inner loop.
- 8.6 A boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored **Did Not Start**.

9. Rules for support persons

9.1 Support persons shall follow Swedish Sailing Federation safety code.

10. Safety regulations

- 10.1 A boat that retires from a race and a boat that does not start shall notify the race committee as soon as possible.
- 10.2 When the water temperature is below +14°C clothing given a good protection against cooling in water shall be worn wet suit, dry suit or similar.

11. Protests and requests for redress

- 11.1 The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last boat has arrived back to the harbor.
- 11.2 Protests shall be delivered to the race office

12. Special information

12.1 According to the Swedish Health Ministry recommendation, we will hereby ask you not to gather in groups on the jetty, but to keep distance to avoid infection by Covid-19




