

Notice of Race (NoR) version 2.0

Swedish and Nordic Championship for KONA ONE

Dates: 2 and 3 September 2023

Location: The strait of Öresund outside the Limhamn, Malmö, Sweden

Boat class: Kona One

Organizing authority: Malmö Segel Sällskap (MSS)

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Class rules for Kona One will apply.
- 1.3 All boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 1.4 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.
- 1.5 When the water temperature is below +14°C a competitor shall wear clothes that prevents from hypothermia, i.e., wetsuit or drysuit.

2. Eligibility

- 2.2 The event both a Senior and Junior class (cadet)
- 2.3 Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. The person in charge, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competition license ("Tävlingslicens") issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 2.4 A competitor shall be at least twelve years old the year the event takes place.



- 2.5 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the competition.
- 2.6 For the Nordic championship all competitors shall be members of a club affiliated to its World Sailing national authority. Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland, Iceland, Estonia, Lithuania, and Latvia are considered as eligible for competition in the Nordic Championship.

3. Entry

- 3.1 Boats may enter the event by completing and paying the entry fee online: <https://www.sailarena.com/sv/se/club/mss/swedish-and-nordic-championship/>
- 3.2 The ordinary entry fee is 900 SEK for seniors and 450 SEK for juniors (up to 15 years), to be paid in Sailarena when making the entry. If the entry is withdrawn not later than August 22, or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee will be refunded.

The extended entry fee is 1000 SEK for seniors and 500 SEK for juniors registration fee for payments received after August 22 and received before September 1st, 2023, at 23.00. After this date and time no entry is allowed.

4. Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registration should be made in Sailarena or at MSS the clubhouse not later than September 2nd, at 09.00.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership, competition license and valid measurement certificate or similar.
- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.
- 4.4 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 4.5 Competitors will be weighted according to Class Rule C.2.3, see figure:

- 4.6 Only **one sail** as per Class Rule C.2.3 may be used in an event, except when the sail has been lost or unintentionally damaged beyond repair. A replacement may be made only with a sail of the **same size** and with the approval of the Race Committee.
- 4.7 An inspection plan is held by the race committee, not official.
- 4.8 Supplementary Sailings Instructions will be handed out at registration.

5. Sailing instructions and information

- 5.1 Sailing instructions and other official information will be available on the official notice board at:

- 5.2 The race committee will when possible and appropriate broadcast information regarding the course, starting times, safety etc. on VHF channel 72.

6. Schedule

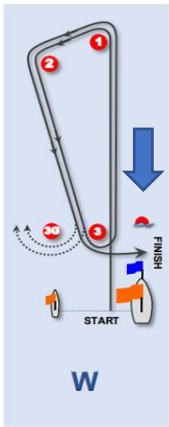

7. Format

- 7.1 8-9 races are scheduled, with a minimum of 4 races over the two days.
- 7.2 The event will consist of a series of races with all boats in the same fleet.

8. Venue and course

- 8.1 The racing area will be west from the Limhamn Harbor in the Strait of Öresund.
- 8.2 The course is as below and further described in the sailing instructions.



The course: Start – 1– 2 – 3/3G – 1 – 2 – 3 – Finish

9. Protests and penalties

- 9.1 RRS appendix P will apply.
As provided under the Racing Rules of Sailing, **the no-pumping rule** shall be enforced either by a protest filed by the race committee against a sailor in violation of Rule 42, or by sound signals and/or flags as follows.

A competitor performing repeated rig movements shall be warned by the on-water umpires by means of a sound signal and/or a yellow flag and penalized with a 720 turn with immediate effect.

This will be handled direct at the course, with no possible protest on the jury at the water. There will not be any handle of this rules after the race.

10. Scoring

- 10.1 RRS A5.3 will apply.
- 10.2 The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided for in RRS 90.3e.
- 10.3 RRS A2.1 is changed so that with three or less races, no score will be excluded. After more than three races one score will be excluded.
- 10.4 Three races are required to constitute a championship.

11. Prizes

11.1 Prizes to approximately 20% of the participants.

11.2 Swedish Championship plaquette and titles may be awarded if:

six or more boats from at least three different Swedish clubs located in more than one Swedish district have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship. The winner will be invited to Seglingens Mästare.

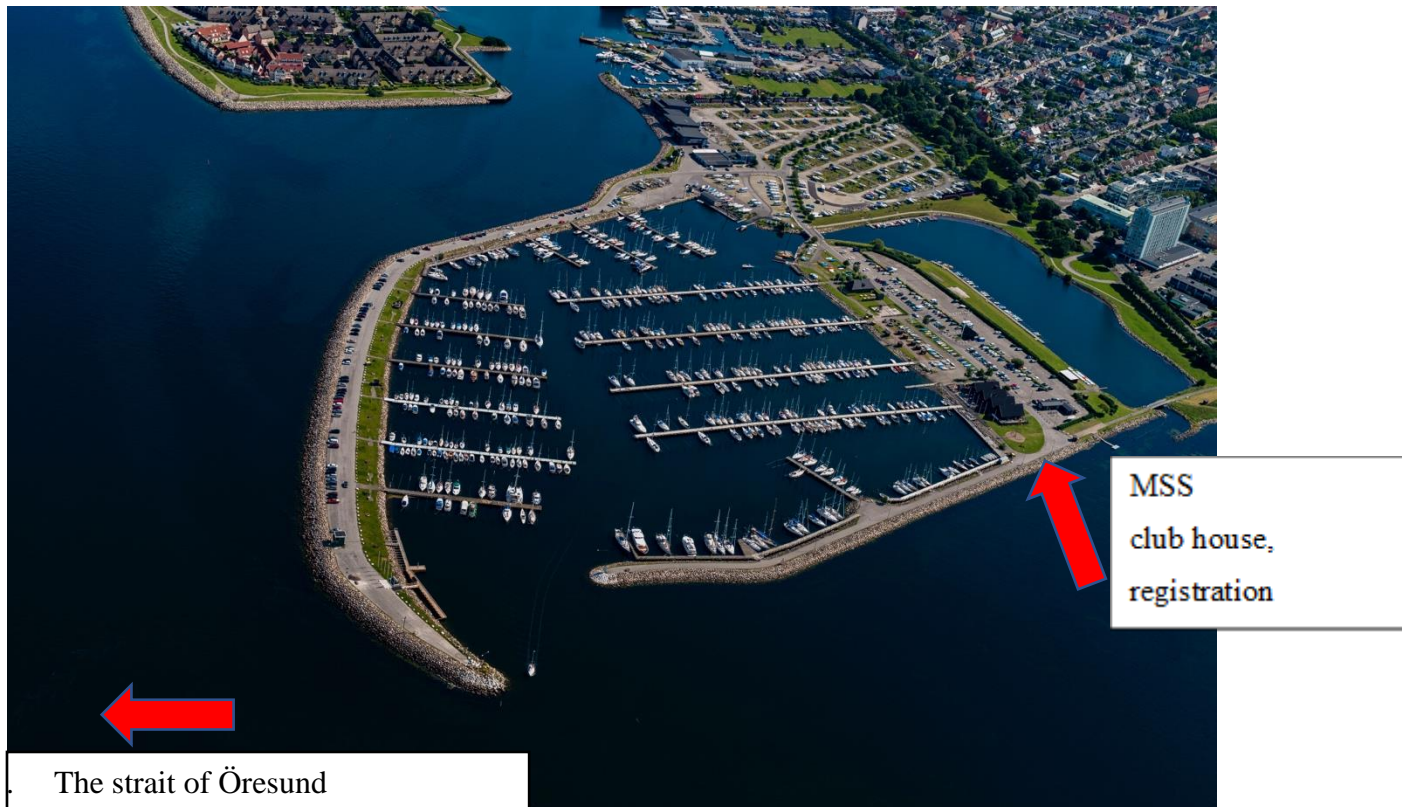
Nordic Championship plaquette and titles may be awarded if:

a) at least 15 competing boats and

b) competing boats from at least three countries in Group G or if there are only two countries, there shall be at least three boats from each.
