

INTERNATIONAL SM J/70 Björkfjärden Ekerö 28 – 30 AUGUST 2020

Notice of Race - Updated

Event: International Swedish Championship for J/70.

Date: Friday 28th of August to 30th of August 2020 **Organizer:** Ekerö Båtklubb (EKBK)

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and with appendix S. The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located online at https://www.sailarena.com/sv/se/club/ekbk/j70-sm/.
- 1.2 The outboard engine may be replaced by one or two water can(s) with a minimum total weight of 20 kg. The can(s) shall be sealed and fixed in a permanent place on board. This changes C5.3 in the Class Rules.
- 1.3 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.
- 1.4 Competitors shall when afloat wear personal flotation devices. This rule does not apply to short-term replacement or adjustment of clothing or personal equipment, or when competitors are in the harbor or under deck. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. This changes RRS 40. A boat that breaks this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.
- 1.5 The competitor that is in charge on board shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This regulation applies from the year the competitor reaches the age of 12. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation.





2. Eligibility requirements

- 2.1 To be entitled to participate in Riksidrottsförbundets championships, each competitor must comply with World Sailing Regulation 19.
- 2.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
- 2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

3. Entries

- The entry fee is 1800 SEK and shall be paid no later than 17th of August 2020 to Register and pay the total amount by credit card via link: https://www.sailarena.com/sv/se/club/ekbk/j70-sm/
 Include the information requested in the form. The registration is not valid until the entry fee is received by the organizer.
- 3.2 After 17th of august 2020, late entry can be made no later than 22nd of August 2020 with an additional fee of 600 SEK. Entry fee for late entry, total of 2400 SEK shall be paid no later than 22nd of August 2020.





4. Registration and measurement checks

- 4.1 Registrations shall be made to the Email address kappsegling@ekerobk.se no later than 10:00 at Friday 28th of August 2020. The Email should tell you are here and a crew list. For further questions regarding the registration please contact Alexander Barnard 070-2671533 at Ekerö Båtklubb.
- 4.2 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, the race- or/and the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection.
- 4.3 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 4.4 A competitor may not be substituted without the written permission of the race committee.

6. Race format

- 6.1 Due to Corona restrictions the fleet will be divided into two start groups.
- 6.2 At Friday and Saturday each boat will be assigned into group defined by a color. There will in total be four groups and in each start two groups are starting together.
- 6.3 At Sunday there will be a Gold and a Silver fleet based on the result from the first two days
- 6.4 At the start boat there will colored class flags indicating which groups that start

7. Racing area

7.1 The racing areas are indicated in the appendix

8. The course

8.1 Windward-leeward/trapezoid course will be sailed. The Racing committee will try to make each race approx. 40-55 minutes depending on the race format.

9. **Protests and penalty systems**

9.1 RRS Appendix T1 will apply

10. Scoring

- 10.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

11. Prizes

- 11.1 Prizes will be given to every five boats.
- 11.2 Championship plaquette and titles may be awarded if six or more boats from at least three different Swedish clubs located in more than one Swedish districts have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.
- 11.3 The main sponsor Grundig will provide a title trophy.

12. Rules for support persons

a) Support persons shall follow Swedish Sailing Federation safety code.

- b) Support person shall follow RRS 1, 2 and 55 and not subject a competitor to risk breaking RRS 41.
- c) During the race, a support person shall not be closer to a competitor than 50 meters, except when the support person acting under RRS 1.1.

13. Media rights and data privacy

- 13.1 By participating in the event, the competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
- 13.2 By participating in the event, the competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right to store the personal information requested in the entry form until the completion of the event.
- 13.3 By participating in the event, the competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to publish competitor name, nationality and sail number in competitor and result lists.

Boat Launch and Berth

Due to Corona restrictions the regatta organization and hosting club is only organizing the regatta at the water and arrangement for the boat launch and berth is up to each crew to organize themselves and pay attention to the rules and restrictions we have right now.

The closest place for boat launch and berth is at Stockholms Segelsällskap harbor at Rastholm Ekerö.

If you want to use these facilities it shall be ordered in advance to Stockholms Segelsällskap, this is done via a Swish payment of 400kr to number 1234993911 (Stockholms Segelsällskap). Mark the Swish note with skipper name and sail number. The boat launch is done with a crane you manage yourselves. The local harbormaster will then appoint a berth

If you have a tender boat to stay at Slandö Kalv is also an alternative. This is an island at Södra Björkfjärden where the harbor have toilet, shower and sauna facilities.

Ekerö Båtklubb can also facilitate a launch via ramp and a berth. To use these facilities do an appointment with the harbor master at Ekerö Båtklubb, number +46 705535971
