- 1.2 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made



- 1.3 Ten (10) races are scheduled during the regatta. There will be a maximum of seven races during Friday and Saturday. At Sunday three races are scheduled in a Gold and Silver fleet.
- 1.4 The race committee will try to set, lay the course so that a race will take approximately 50 minutes to sail.

### 3 Marks

- 3.1 The rounding marks are big yellow or orange cylinders (W, W/O and gates).
- 3.2 The rounding mark W/I is a smaller yellow cylinder.
- 3.3 New rounding marks when changing the course are same as the original.
- 3.4 The start mark is an orange flag buoy and an orange flag on the Race Committee boat.
- 3.5 The finish mark is a blue flag buoy and a blue flag on the Race Committee boat.
- 3.6 When changing the course the original marks will be moved. This changes RRS Appendix S 10.1





























### 4 Time limits

- 4.1 Race Time Limit  
Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 100 minutes.
- 4.2 Finishing Window  
Finishing window is 25 minutes.



## 5 Changes and additions to RRS appendix S

- 5.1 The course is a Windward-leeward/trapezoid course, see figure on last page.  
Start – W/i – W – W/O – W/i – Gate – W/i – W – W/O – W/i – Finish
- 5.2 Competitors at Friday and Saturday are divided in 4 groups e.g. YELLOW, GREEN, BLUE, RED. We will use the letters Y, G, B, R to define the colors
- 5.3 Groups, colors and sailing order for;

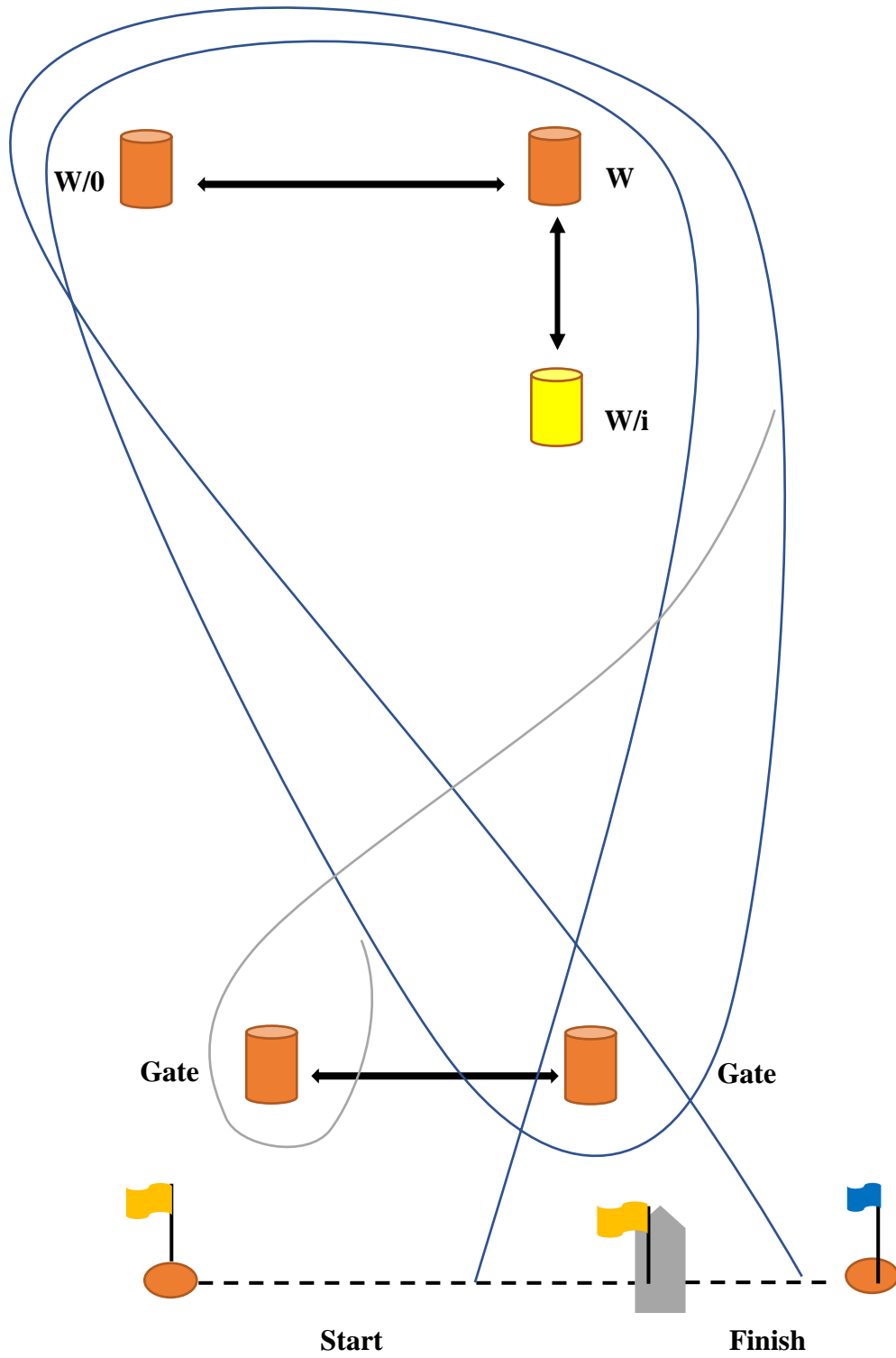

- 5.4 Gold fleet have a YELLOW class flag. Silver fleet have a GREEN class flag.
- 5.5 The Race committee will not show the course as stated in RRS Appendix S7.1. This changes RRS Appendix S 7.1

- 5.6 A boat starting later than 15 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. This changes RRS Appendix 4.
- 5.7 The finishing line is between a blue flag buoy and a blue flag on the Race Committee boat. This changes RRS Appendix S 11.1
- 5.8 The scoring penalty, RRS 44.3, will not apply.
- 5.9 The RC will use VHF radio (channel 72) to assist on individual/general recall. Delay or failure to broadcast or receive broadcast shall not be grounds to request for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a)
- 5.10 Change of next leg of the course
- 5.10.1 The position of any laid inflated mark(s) maybe adjusted by up to approximately plus or minus 15 degrees relative to its previous position and/or up to approximately 200 metres to windward or leeward without a signal. This changes RRS 33.
- 5.10.2 For changes greater than those described in SI 5.7.1. To change the next leg of the course, the RC will move the original mark(s)(or move the finishing line).
- 5.10.3 The RC will use VHF radio (channel 72) communicating, any changes of the next leg of the course. Delay or failure to broadcast or receive broadcast shall not be grounds to request for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a)

**Start – W/i - W – W/O - W/i – Gate – W/i - W – W/O - W/i – Finish**

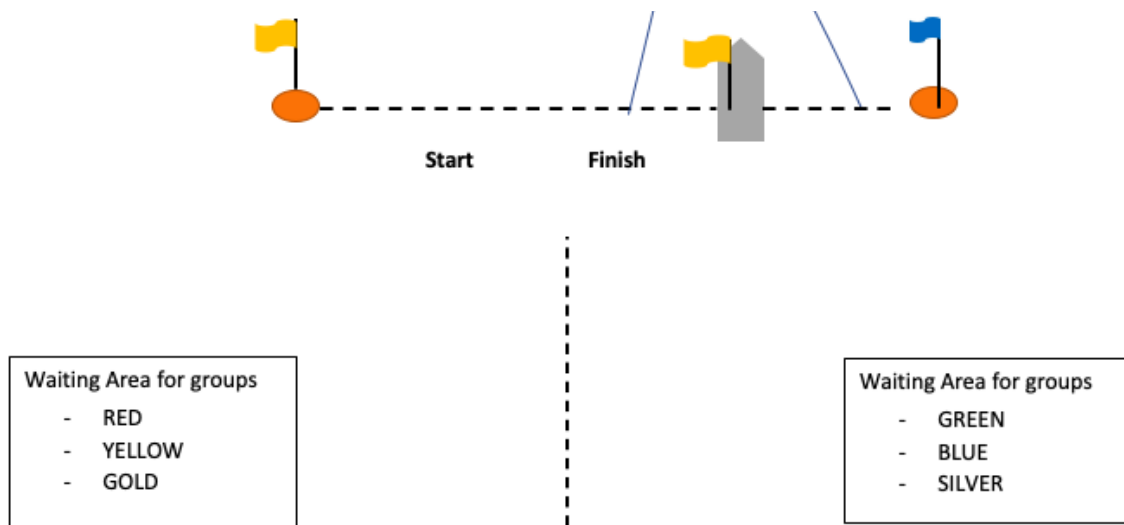
## Race Area



## Area to be in while not racing

Since there are restrictions to limit the number of boats in the start area, there are defined areas the boat shall be in.

- Boats in RED, YELLOW and the GOLD group shall be to the left of the Race Committee boat
- Boats in GREEN, BLU and the SILVER group shall be to the right of the Race Committee boat
