



## Notice of Race (NoR)



### Nordic & Swedish Para Inclusive Sailing Championships 2026

<b>Dates:</b>	4-6 September 2026
<b>Location:</b>	KSSS/ Skota Hem Hotellvägen 9, Saltsjöbaden
<b>Boatclass:</b>	RS Venture Connect SCS The maximum number of crews is 18
<b>Organizing authority:</b>	Royal Swedish Yacht Club (KSSS) in cooperation with Trim the Sails Foundation (Skota Hem)

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The following rules/regulations will also apply:
  - a) The Rules for Nordic Championship
  - b) World Sailing Race Management Manual Appendix Z, Part 1
  - c) The Para-Classification Rules of Sailing
- 1.3 [DP] RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.

#### 2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All crews competing shall have a third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of SEK 5.000.000 per event or equivalent.

## 2.2 Para Class

The event is Para Class and in addition, an Inclusive Class in the Nordic Championship.

- a) Three championship titles will be awarded:  
Para Nordic Champion, Inclusive Nordic Champion and Para Swedish Champion.  
Only Swedish citizens can compete in the Swedish Sailing Para Championship.
- b) Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of its national authority. A person in charge, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competition license (Tävlingssicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- c) Sailors shall have a valid International Classification according to the Para-Classification Rules for World Sailing.
- d) Minimal Impairment criteria will apply.
- e) The Nordic championship is open also to crews from countries outside Group G.

## 2.3 Inclusive Class

- a) For participation in the Inclusive Class in the Nordic Championship, no Para Classification is required.
- b) For teams competing for awards in the Inclusive Class, a self-declaration of a minimum disability, condition, or illness that affects daily life must apply to at least one athlete(s) of the team entered. The OA reserves the right to review this self-declaration pre-event, or during the competition.
- c) The person in charge shall be a member of a club that is a member of her national authority.

## 2.4 Total number of entries

The maximum number of crews is 18. The OA reserves the right to decide the participants at its absolute discretion.

## 3. Entry

**3.1** Crews may enter the event by registering online at the [Official Notice Board \(ONB\)](#) not later than 10<sup>th</sup> August 2026. Late entry may be approved by the race committee but not later than 1<sup>st</sup> September.

**3.2** To encourage early entries and facilitate proper planning there are three different levels of entry fees:

<b>Early Entry</b> Before 1 june	<b>Standard Entry</b> 1 june - 10 aug	<b>Late Entry</b> 11 aug – 1 sept
3.000 SEK per team	3.500 SEK per team	4.500 SEK per team

The entry fee is paid in SailArena when making the entry.

If the entry is withdrawn no later than August 10<sup>th</sup>, or if the crew's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee will be refunded.

A crew wanting to withdraw from the competition until 1 September is free to sell/transfer its entry to another crew, in the same class, not already entered.

- 3.3** The entry fee includes shared boat charter and a social event. All crews entering the event will also be invited to one day of complimentary pre-regatta training.

#### **4. Registration and equipment inspection**

- 4.1** Arrival registration will be completed after a complete entry is made in SailArena latest 18:00 3<sup>rd</sup> of September at the Race Office.

- 4.2** The competitors shall, upon request, be able to verify club membership, Para-Classification (if you compete in the Para-class), competition license, and a third-party liability insurance certificate.

- 4.3** A boat, crew, or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water, the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.

- 4.4** A competitor that has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the race committee, but not the person in charge.

- 4.5** Competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are **not** allowed to participate in the competition.

#### **5. Sailing instructions and information**

- 5.1** Sailing instructions and other official information will be available on the [Official Notice Board](#) at the latest at 12:00 hrs on 3<sup>rd</sup> of September.

#### **6. Schedule**

##### **Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> of September**

10:00 – 17:00	Training (schedule on later notice)
10:00 – 17:00	Classification (if requested no later than 3 <sup>rd</sup> of August)
12:00 – 18:00	Arrival registration at the Race Office

##### **Friday 4<sup>th</sup> of September**

09:00	Opening ceremony and Skippers meeting
10:30	First warning signal

##### **Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> of September**

10:00	First warning signal
	After Sail when the last race is finished

## **Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> of September**

10:00	First warning signal
16:00	Latest warning signal (last race)

Prize giving ceremony after racing is finished, no later than 16:30.

### **7. Format**

- 7.1** The organizing authority will supply boats and aim to make all competitors sail 6-8 races each.
- 7.2** The race committee plans to run a number of short races for all classes in mixed fleets, in a series. The race committee might decide to separate the Inclusive crews if there is a sufficient number entered.
- 7.3** The sailing schedule will be published at the ONB on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> of September.

### **8. Venue and course**

- 8.1** Baggensfjärden and/or Hotellviken, Saltsjöbaden. The course area will be located close to the harbor.
- 8.2** The course will be a windward/leeward course as described in the sailing instructions.

### **9. Protests and penalties**

- 9.1** RRS appendix P will apply.
- 9.2** RRS appendix T1 will apply.
- 9.3** Penalties for breaking rules related to functional adaptations: When a protest committee decides that a boat has broken rules related to functional adaptations, or a class rule, it may disqualify the boat or impose a scoring penalty or give a warning.

### **10. Scoring**

- 10.1** The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided for in RRS 90.3e.
- 10.2** RRS A2.1 is changed so that with three or less races, no score will be excluded. After more than three races one score will be excluded.
- 10.3** Three races are required to constitute a championship (applies to both championships).

## 11. Prizes

- 11.1** Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 teams in all 3 classes (Nordic Championship Para & Inclusive and Swedish Para Sailing Championship).
- 11.2** Para and Inclusive Nordic Championship plaquettes and titles may be awarded if:
- a) at least 6 competing para-crews and
  - b) competing para-crews from at least three countries in Group G or if there are only two countries, there shall be at least three crews from each country that have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.
- 11.3** The Swedish Championship (SM) plaquette and titles will be awarded as stated in the "SSF Tävlingsreglemente".
- 11.4** The winner of a Swedish Para Sailing championship is invited to the regatta "Seglingens Mästare". Entry to "Seglingens Mästare" shall be done in SailArena no later than 14 days after the Swedish Championship is finished.
- 11.5** KSSS prizes in each class according to the number of crews entered in the class: one prize for every five crews or part of five up to eight prizes per class.

## 12. Support Persons

- 12.1** Support person shall launch, moor and take up his vessel (coach-boat) according to the instructions from the organizer upon arrival.
