## Notice of Race

**Event:** *International Swedish Championship for J/70.*

**Date:** Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> of August to 18<sup>th</sup> of August 2019

**Organizer:** Karlstads Segelsällskap, Karlstads Kappseglingsförening and Skoghalls Båtsällskap

### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and with appendix S.  
The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the race office at Karlstads Segelsällskap.
- 1.2 The outboard engine may be replaced by one or two water can(s) with a minimum total weight of 20 kg. The can(s) shall be sealed and fixed in a permanent place on board. This changes C5.3 in the Class Rules.
- 1.3 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]
- 1.4 Competitors shall when afloat wear personal flotation devices. This rule does not apply to short-term replacement or adjustment of clothing or personal equipment, or when competitors are in the harbor or under deck. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. This changes RRS 40. A boat that breaks this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee (DP).

- 1.5 The competitor that is in charge on board shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This regulation applies from the year the competitor reaches the age of 12. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation.

## 2. Eligibility requirements

- 2.1 To be entitled to participate in Riksidrottsförbundets championships, each competitor must comply with World Sailing Regulation 19.
- 2.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
- 2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 3. Entries

- 3.1 Entry shall be made no later than 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2019 online at <https://www.sailarena.com/en/se/club/kdss/internationellt-sm-j70> and include the information requested in the form. The registration is not valid until the entry fee is received by the organizer.

- 3.2 The entry fee is 2.200 SEK and shall be paid no later than 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2019 to

- 3.3 After 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2019, late entry can be made no later than 11<sup>th</sup> of August 2019 with an additional fee of 800 SEK. Entry fee for late entry, total of 3000 SEK shall be paid no later than 11<sup>th</sup> of August 2019.
- 3.4 Regatta Dinner will be held at Scandic Hotel Winn on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> of August 2019. The fee is 350 SEK/person and includes a regatta buffet and two glasses of wine, beer or non-alcoholic beverages. It shall be booked and paid separately no later than 11<sup>th</sup> of August 2019 as described in the attachment.



#### 4. Registration and measurement checks

- 4.1 Registrations shall be made at the race office at Karlstads Segelsällskap no later than 09:00 on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> of August 2019.
- 4.2 Measurement certificates shall be presented prior to racing.
- 4.3 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, the race- or/and the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection.
- 4.4 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 4.5 A competitor may not be substituted without the written permission of the race committee.

## **6. Race format**

- 6.1 The International Swedish Championship for J/70 will be held as a fleet racing in a straight series.

## **7. Racing area**

- 7.1 The racing areas will be east of the port of Karlstad on Sättersholmsfjärden.

## **8. The course**

- 8.1 Windward-leeward/trapezoid course will be sailed. The Racing committee will try to make each race approx. 50 minutes.

## **9. Protests and penalty systems**

- 9.1 RRS Appendix T1 will apply

## **10. Scoring**

- 10.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

## **11. Prizes**

- 11.1 Prizes will be given to every five boats.
- 11.2 Championship plaquette and titles may be awarded if six or more boats from at least three different Swedish clubs located in more than one Swedish districts have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.
- 11.3 The main sponsor Grundig will provide a title trophy.

## **12. Rules for support persons**

- a) Support persons shall follow Swedish Sailing Federation safety code.
- b) Support person shall launch, berth and take up his craft (coach boat) as directed by the organizer.
- c) Support person shall follow RRS 1, 2 and 55 and not subject a competitor to risk breaking RRS 41.

- d) During the race, a support person shall not be closer to a competitor than 50 meters, except when the support person acting under RRS 1.1.

### 13. Media rights and data privacy

- 13.1 By participating in the event, the competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
- 13.2 By participating in the event, the competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right to store the personal information requested in the entry form until the completion of the event.
- 13.3 By participating in the event, the competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to publish competitor name, nationality and sail number in competitor and result lists.

### 14. Sustainability

Lake Vänern is the largest freshwater source in Sweden and thus sensitive for pollution. All sailors, coaches, race officials and volunteers are responsible for the health of our waters. We are committed to limiting the negative environmental impacts of the event and we expect everyone involved to follow the below guidelines.

- 14.1 Bring your own personal reusable water bottle. No single use plastic water bottles will be allowed. If you use sport drinks, please bring powdered sports drink mixes to use in your reusable water bottle.
- 14.2 No plastic bags or single use plastics are allowed at the regatta venue. Please bring only reusable items such as canvas bags and food containers.
- 14.3 All waste must be disposed of in proper containers: Recycling & Landfill.
- 14.4 All boats may only be cleaned in the designated area. Please refrain from using detergents that may affect water quality.
- 14.5 Prevent marine debris. Keep your trash secure on board so it does not blow into the water.
- 14.6 When fueling, please fill fuel tanks slowly and use absorbent pads to catch drips and spills. Do not overflow your fuel tank. Try to leave the tank 10% empty to allow fuel to expand as it warms.

- 14.7 Please make sure your engine is well maintained to make sure there are no oil or fuel leaks.
- 14.8 Reduce fuel consumption by turning off your engine when safe to do so, anchoring instead of idling and reducing your speeds to a steady pace.
