Notice of Race International Swedish Championship 606

Date: 9-11/8 2024

Location: Gävle, Sweden

Competition level: Red

Class: 606

Organizing club: Gefle Segel Sällskap

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and with appendix S.

The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the race office in Gefle Segel Sällskap.

- 1.2 The 606 class rules will apply.
Swedish National prescriptions do apply and will be published on the official notice board located at the GSS Race office.
- 1.3 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

- 1.4 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. However, it does not apply on a keelboat when it is moored or when the competitor is below deck. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.
- 1.5 The competitor that is in charge on board shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This regulation applies from the year the competitor reaches the age of 12. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation.
- 1.6 If there is any discrepancy between NOR and Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions, the Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions will prevail.
- 1.7 The event is an open class.
- 1.8 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the competition.
- 1.9 A competitor that has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the race committee. However, the person in charge may not be changed.

2. Eligibility requirements

- 2.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance.
- 2.2 The competitor that is in charge on board shall be a member of a club associated with Swedish Sailing Federation. This rule is not applicable for non-Swedish competitor.
- 2.3 The competitor that is in charge on board shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This rule is not applicable for non-Swedish competitor.
- 2.4 To be entitled to participate in the Swedish Sport Federation championships, each competitor must be at age 12 years or older at the year of the regatta.
- 2.5 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

3. Entries

3.1 Entry shall be made not later than July 9

If the entry is cancelled no later than August 1, the entry fee will be paid back.

Late entry fee is 2.900 SEK, possible until August 8.

4. Registration and measurement checks

4.1 Registrations shall be made at the race office not later than Friday, August 9 at 8.50.

4.2 Competitor in charge of Swedish boats confirm sailing club membership, a valid license. All competitors show measurement certificate or similar.

4.3 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, the race- or/and the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection.

4.4 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to then Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

4.5 Measurement services will not be available during the specified time for registration.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice located at GSS race office.
- 5.2 Race committee may inform about race course, start times, safety etc. at VHF channel 72.

7. Race format

- 7.1 9 fleet races are planned.

8. The course and Racing area

- 8.1 The racing areas will be held on the waters outside Gefle Segel Sällskap's harbor. 2 racing areas can be used depending on weather and wind conditions. These can be found in a separate document in Sailarena.
- 8.2 The race course will be windward-leeward.

9. Protests and penalty systems

9.1 RRS Appendix P will apply

9.2 RRS Appendix T1 will apply

10. Scoring

10.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

10.3 The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided for in RRS 90.3e.

11. Prizes

11.1 The three first boats will be awarded the plaquette of Swedish Sports Confederation. Prizes will also go to every fifth boat.

12 Rules for support persons

a) Support persons shall follow Swedish Sailing Federation safety code.

b) Support person shall launch, berth and take up his craft (coach boat) as directed by the organizer.

c) Support person shall follow RRS 1, 2 and 55 and not subject a competitor to risk breaking RRS 41.

d) During the race, a support person shall not be closer to a competitor than 50 meters, except when the support person acting under RRS 1.1.

- **After Sail**
Every day after the race, hot dogs are served with hot and cold drinks and are included in the entry fee.
- **Regatta dinner**, Saturday is included for 2 sailors in the entry fee. Extra tickets for the regatta dinner can be purchased at a cost of 350 SEK before August 1. However, the sooner the better so we can make necessary reservations in the clubhouse restaurant.
- **Breakfast** and sandwiches between races, Friday, Saturday and Sunday – is served in the clubhouse restaurant between 07.00 – 09.00 at cost of 90 SEK per person and day. Booking and payment is done at GSS Race Office latest one day ahead. In case you are allergic, intolerant to gluten or similar, please inform beforehand to klubbmastare@gss.nu so we can prepare alternative. While having breakfast you can prepare your own food/sandwiches to bring with you and eat between the races. This is included in the breakfast fee!
