Dates: August 26-28, 2022

Location: The Club Island of Nyköpings Segelsällskap "Broken", Nyköping.

Boatclass: A22

Organizing authority: Nyköpings Segelsällskap (NYSS)

1. Rules

The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. However, it does not apply on a keelboat when it is mored or when the competitor is below deck. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All boats competing shall have a third party liability insurance.
- 2.2 The person in charge shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority.
- 2.3 The person in charge who is a Swedish citizen shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 2.4 A competitor shall be at least twelve years old the same year this event takes place.

3. Entry

- 3.1 Boats may enter the event by registrering online at Sailarena <u>www.sailarena.com</u> not later than July 30, 2022. If you experience problems with the registration, please contact Daniel Ekstrand (+46 70 485 26 73, daniel_ekstrand@yahoo.com)
- 3.2 The entry fee is 1 500 SEK and is payed in Sailarena when making the entry. Late entry fee is 2 000 SEK. If the entry is withdrawn not later than 25 days before the event, or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee will be refunded, less an administration fee of 10%.

The entry should contain the following information: skipper, crew, club, sail number, insurance company.

Order and payment for the competitors dinner on the Saturday evening shall be made at the same time as the entry for the competition. The competitors dinner costs 350 SEK/person including one beer/glass of wine/non alcoholic alternative. Nyköpings Segelsällskap will not be able to offer breakfast or lunch packages. 22 klubben (the A22 club) hope however to be able to offer breakfast and lunch packages, please see www.sk22.se after July 10th for more information regarding this.

You will be able to buy hamburgers and beverages Thursday night and directly after the racing on Friday and Sunday night. These cannot be booked in advance.

4. Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registration of the whole crew should be made in the club house at Broken not later than Thursday August 25th.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership, competition license and valid measurement certificate or similar.
- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.
- 4.4 A competitor that has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the race committee.

5. Sailing instructions and information

5.1 Sailing instructions consist of RRS appendix S and additional sailing instructions. These will be available att NYSS' website and be handed out at registration. Other official information will be available on the official notice board.

The official notice board is at the shed next to the beach at Broken.

7. Format

- 7.1 Eight races are scheduled.
- 7.2 The event will consist of a series of races with all boats in the same class in the same fleet.

8. Venue and course

- 8.1 Racing will be held at Örsbaken
- 8.2 The course will be a winward/leeward course as described in the sailing instructions. The racing committee aim for 45 to 60 minute long races.

9. Protests and penalties

- 9.1 RRS appendix TX section B about penalties after racing will apply.
- 9.2 RRS 44.1 is changed from "A boat may take a Two-Turns Panalty..." to "A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty...".

10. Scoring

- 10.1 RRS A5.3 will apply.
- 10.2 The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided for in RRS 90.3e.
- 10.3 RRS A2.1 is changed so that with three or less races, no score will be excluded. After more than three races one score will be excluded.
- 10.4 Three races are required to constitute a championship.

11. Prizes

- 11.1 22 klubben's regular Swedish Championship prizes will be given out.
- 11.2 SSF's Tävlingsreglemente 2021, chapter 8 "Mästerskap" will apply.

11.3 If the winner of the Swedish Championship is a Swedish citizen, he/she will be invited to the competition "Seglingens Mästare".
