Notice of Race Nordic Championship J/70 Sandhamn 9th-11th August 2018

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), with appendix S and rules for the Nordic Championships.

 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be available online www.ksss.se
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Swedish Sailing Federation will not apply.
- 1.3 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.
- 1.4 The competitor that is in charge on board shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This regulation applies from the year the competitor reach the age of 13. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation.

2. Eligibility requirements

- 2.1 Competitors shall comply with World Sailing regulation 19.
- 2.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
- 2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.





3. Entries

- 3.1 Entry shall be made no later than 23rd of July 2018 and the registration shall be done online at www.ksss.se and include the information requested in the form. The entry registration is not valid until the entry fee is received by the Organizer.
- 3.2 The entry fee is 2 600 SEK and shall be paid to KSSS online upon entry.
- 3.4 After 23rd of July 2018 entry registration can be done for an additional fee of 800 SEK until 6th of August 2018.
- 3.5 The Regatta Dinner will be held on the evening of Saturday of 11th August. It shall be booked and paid online latest August 6th www.ksss.se

4. Registration and measurement checks

- 4.1 Registrations shall be made at the Race office at KSSS Sandhamn not later than 09:55 on 9th August.
- 4.2 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, the race- or/and the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection.
- 4.3 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 4.5 A competitor may not be substituted without the written permission of the Race committee.

6. Race format

6.1 The Nordic Championship for J/70 will be held as a fleet racing in a straight serie.

7. Racing area

7.1 The racing areas will be around Sandhamn

8. The course

8.1 Windward-leeward course will be sailed. The Racing committee will try to make each race approx. 50 minutes.

9. Protests and penalty systems

9.2 RRS Appendix T1 will apply





10. Scoring

- 10.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

11. Prizes

- 11.1 To constitute a Nordic Championship the event shall have
 - (a) at least 15 competing boats and
 - (b) competing boats from at least three countries in Group G or if there are only two countries, there shall be at least three boats from each.
- 11.2 KSSS will be handing out prizes for every five boats up to maximum five prizes
- 11.3 Gold, silver and bronze plaques of Nordic Sailing Federation shall be awarded to the best three crews.

12. Rules for support persons

- 12.1 Support person shall follow RRS 1, 2 and 55 and not subject a competitor to risk breaking RRS 41.
- During the race, a support person shall not be closer to a competitor than 50 meters, except when the support person acting under RRS 1.1.

13. Media rights

13.1 By participating in the event, the competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
