



Supplementary Sailings Instructions

Event: Swedish Championship for Snipe
Date: 19th – 20th September 2020
Organizer: Segel Sällskapet Kaparen (SSKa)

1. Time schedule

1.1 Dates of racing

Saturday 19th	4 races are scheduled
09.10	Competitor's Briefing
10.15	First warning signal for the day
Sunday 20th	3 races are scheduled
09.55	First warning signal for the day
As soon as possible after the last race	Prize giving ceremony at clubhouse

On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15.00

- 1.2 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.
- 1.3 7 races are scheduled during the regatta.
- 1.4 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- 1.5 The race committee will try to set lay the course so that a race will take approximately 45 minutes to sail.

2. Location of the race office, flagpole, and official Notice Board

- 2.1 The race office is in the club house in Gottskär harbour
- 2.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed at flagpole close to the club house
- 2.3 The official Notice Board is shared with SNIPE and STARBOAT and is on the homepage of Sailarena: <https://www.sailarena.com/sv/se/club/sska/sm-i-snipe>

3. Notices to competitors


- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board and will also be sent out via VHF



4. Changes to sailing instructions

- 4.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 08.00 on the day it will take effect.
- 4.2 Any change to the time schedule will be posted before 18.00 on the day before it will take effect.

5. Signals made ashore

- 5.1 When flag AP  is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 60 minutes' in race signal AP.

6. Marks



- 6.1 The rounding marks are yellow buoys.
- 6.2 Rounding marks when changing the course are yellow buoys
- 6.3 The starting line will be between an orange flag on the committee boat and a buoy with a red flag.
- 6.4 The finishing line will be between a buoy with a blue flag and a committee boat with a blue flag.
- 6.5 When changing the course, the original mark will be moved.

7. Time limits


- 7.1 Race Time Limit
Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 90 minutes.
- 7.2 Finishing Window
Finishing window is 25 minutes.

8. The course

- 8.1 The course is a triangular or windward-leeward course as shown in the attachments.
- 8.2 The courses will be according to SCIRA Official Rulebook

The 0- flag  for triangular course and W-flag  for windward/leeward course will apply. **See attachments 1 and 2**

Each rounding- mark to be left to port.

- 8.2 The course will be displayed directly when the start procedure begins at the moment when the accurate class flag is shown.
- 8.3 If the flag  T is displayed when the start procedure begins at the moment when the accurate class flag is shown, the course will be sailed in three laps. **See attachment.**



8.4 Class/start Flag

8.5 A boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored **Did Not Start**.

9. Rules for support persons

9.1 Support persons shall follow Swedish Sailing Federation safety code.

10. Safety regulations

10.1 A boat that retires from a race and a boat that does not start shall notify the race committee as soon as possible.

10.2 When the water temperature is below +14°C clothing given a good protection against cooling in water shall be worn – wet suit, dry suit or similar.

11. Protests and requests for redress

11.1 For each class, the protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later. This changes RRS App. L 16.2

12. Special information

12.1 There will be another boat class e.g.- STAR BOAT sailing the triangular course in this Regatta.

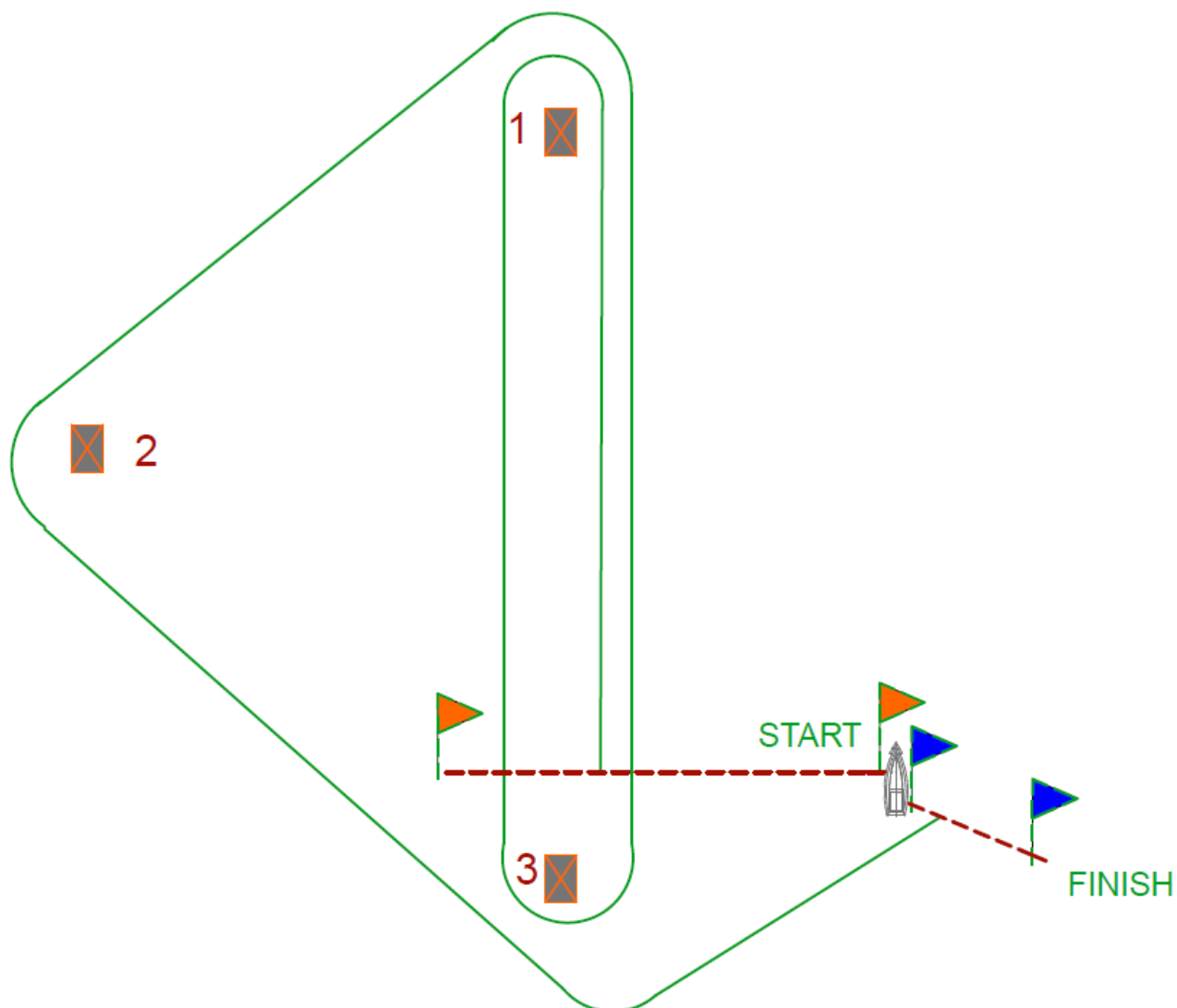

Start -1-3-1-2-3-finish

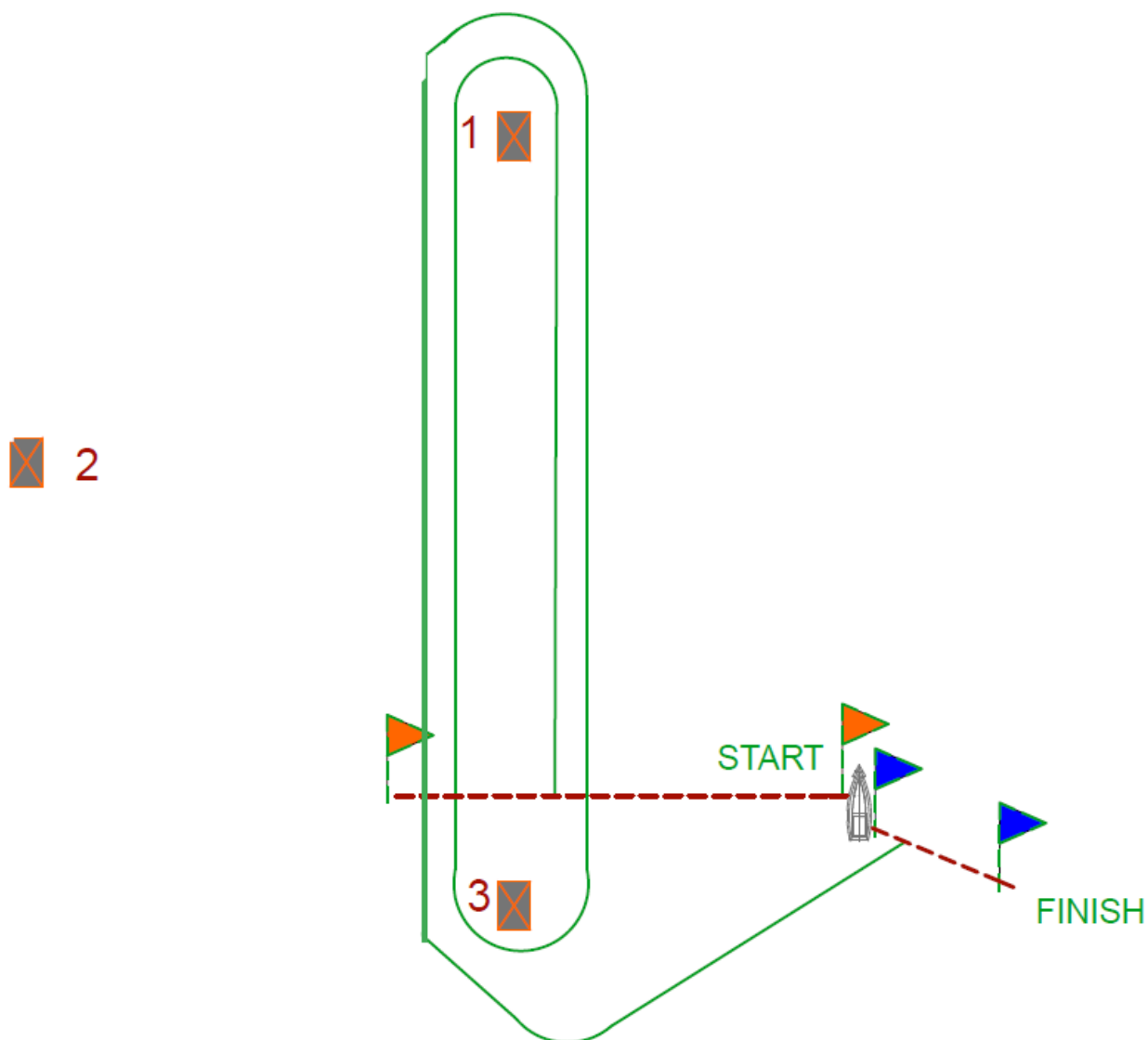
If three lapses:
