



NOTICE OF RACE

Nordic Championship Regatta for the 2.4mR class

Date: May 24-26 2024

Venue: Ljungskile

Format: 2.4mR Open Class

Organizing club: Ljungskile Segelsällskap

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and with Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 When the water temperature drops below +14°C, competitors must wear clothing that provides good protection against cold in water, such as a wetsuit or dry suit.
- 1.3 RRS 61.1 (a)(2) has been amended so that a boat intending to protest must display a protest flag, according to RRS 61.1 (a).
- 1.4 RRS 44.1 has been changed, so that in the event of a violation of the rule in part 2, a boat may take a one-turn penalty.
- 1.5 RRS rule 31, touching a mark, is replaced by rule C2.14 (Appendix C, Rules of Matchracing).

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 Competing boats must be insured in such a way that the person responsible on board has liability insurance that covers a claim for damages of up to SEK 5 million.
- 2.2 Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. A person in charge, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation
- 2.3 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors who are Russian or Belarusian citizens, are not allowed to participate in the race.

3. Registration

- 3.1 Registration must be made in Sailarena, www.sailarena.com no later than 12 May 2024.
- 3.2 The registration fee is 1.100 SEK for those who have registered within the prescribed time. The amount must be paid to Ljungskile Segelsällskap bg-nr 867-1794, alternatively IBAN: SE47 6000 0000 0009 6903 9298 BIC/SWIFT code HANDSESS, in order for the registration to be completed and valid. If cancellation is made no later than May 19 or if the organizer rejects a boat's registration, the registration fee will be refunded.
- 3.3 Registration later than May 12 may be made. Payment can then only be made in cash/Swish at arrival registration no later than 08.30 on Saturday 25 May. The amount is then increased to 1.300 SEK.

4. Registration and inspection

- 4.1 Registration must be done at the race office no later than Saturday 25 May at 08.30.
- 4.2 The person in charge on board must be able to prove club membership and racing license and, upon request, be able to show the boat's measurement certificate or equivalent.
- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment can be checked for compliance with the rules at any time. On the water, the Racing Committee or the Technical Committee may instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a designated location for inspection.

5. Sailing Instructions & Information

5.1 The sailing instructions consist of RRS appendix S, Standard Sailing Instruction, and supplementary sailing instruction. The supplementary sailing instruction and other official information will be available on the official notice board to the left of the clubhouse entrance.

Prize giving ceremony will be held as soon as possible after the end of the races, including any protest negotiations.

7. Implementation

- 7.1 7 races are scheduled.
- 7.2 The event will consist of a series of races with all boats in the same fleet.

8. Racing area and course

- 8.1 The races are planned to take place on the bay outside the clubhouse, northeast of Ulvön. Alternative course area is in an area south to west of Ulvön. See appendix 1 (including other organizer info).
- 8.2 Courses will be windward/leeward, and all marks will be left to port. The length of the course is adjusted so that the sailed time should be about 50-60 minutes for the first boat to finish.

9. Protests and penalties

9.1 RRS T1 apply.

10. Scoring

- 10.1 The Race Committee will not make any changes to results 24 hours after the last race under the conditions set out in RRS 90.3e.
- 10.2 RRS A2.1 is amended so that if three or fewer races have been completed, all races will be counted and if there are more than three completed races, one may be excluded.
- 10.3 At least three races must be completed for the race to be counted as a championship.

11. Prizes

11.1 Prizes will be awarded for every 5 starting boats. The Nordic Sailing Federation's championship plaques are awarded to the three best placed participants. Prizes are also awarded to the best disabled and Grand Master sailor respectively. For these categories, there are at least three starters in each category.
