



Supplementary Sailings Instructions

**Event: Open Swedish Championship for Melges 24
Danish and Nordic Championships**



Date: August 7-9 2020

Organizer: Halmstads Segelsällskap

1. Time schedule

1.1 Dates of racing

Day	Date	The planned time of the warning signal for the first race each day is
Friday	2020 08 07	Time: (13.00 Practice starts) 14.00
Saturday	2020 08 08	Time: 10.00
Sunday	2020 08 09	Time: 10.00

On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15.00

1.2 To alert boats that a race will begin soon, the red starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.

1.3 9 races are scheduled during the regatta

1.4 The race committee will try to lay the course so that a race will take approximately 45 minutes to sail.

2. Location of the race office and of the flagpole

2.1 The regatta office is located at HSS Clubhouse

2.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the flag pole in front of the HSS Clubhouse

3. Marks

3.1 The rounding marks are yellow cylinder bouys.

The start marks are a red flag on the starboard committee boat / a red flag on the port side committee boat.

The finish marks are a blue flag on the starboard committee boat / a blue flag on the port side committee boat

- 3.2 When changing the course the original mark will be moved. This changes RRS Appendix SI 10.1

4. Time limits

- 4.1 Race Time Limit
Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 80 minutes.

- 4.2 Finishing Window
Finishing window is 20 minutes.

5. Changes and additions to RRS appendix S

- 5.1 When flag "T" is displayed before or together with the warning signal the course shall be sailed three laps.
- 5.2 The classflag is flag "E"
This changes RRS Appendix SI 6.1
- 5.3 The Race committee will not show the course as stated in RRS Appendix SI 7.1.
This changes AppSI 7.1
- 5.5 A boat starting later than 15 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. This changes RRS Appendix A4.
- 5.6 The finishing line is between a blue flag on the starboard committee boat and a blue flag on the port side committee boat
This changes RRS Appendix SI 11.1

6. Communication.

- 6.1 Radio communication with the race committee during the regatta will be on the VHF channel 72. The race committee may transmit confirmation of any race signal over VHF. Failure to make a broadcast or to time it accurately will not be grounds for a request for redress by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(b).
- 6.2 Except when communicating with the race committee, in an emergency or when using equipment provided by the race committee or the organizing authority a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones and watches with communications capability. This changes RRS 41.

7 Safety regulations

A boat that retires from a race and a boat that does not start shall notify the race committee as soon as possible.
