# **Notice of Race**

Event: No Emission Race - Open Swedish Championship & Open Nordic Championship for 505

Date: 8~10 July 2022

Organizer: Gefle Segelsällskap, Gävle, SWEDEN

### 1. Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and with appendix S.

The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the race office in Gefle Segelsällskap.

- 1.2 The class rules for 505 class will apply.
- 1.3 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]
- 1.4 Competitors shall when afloat wear personal flotation devices. This rule does not apply to short-term replacement or adjustment of clothing or personal equipment, or when competitors are in the harbor. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. This changes RRS 40. A boat that breaks this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee (*DP*).
- 1.5 The competitor that is in charge on board shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This regulation applies from the year the competitor reaches the age of 12. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation.
- 1.6 If there is any discrepancy between NOR and Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions, the Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions will prevail.
- 1.7 By entering the regatta, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority, their sponsors and the Swedish 505 Association the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any films, pictures or other reproductions of the competitors during the period of the competition without compensation.

1.8 Competitors must follow all reasonable instructions from the Racing Committee regarding behavior on land and during transport to and from the track area due to the ongoing Corona pandemic. A competitor or crew who violates this can be punished in the way the protest committee deems appropriate (DP). KSR 36 does not apply to violations of this rule.

# 2. Eligibility requirements

- To be entitled to participate in Riksidrottsförbundets championships, each competitor must comply with World Sailing Regulation 19.
   Championship can only be won by a boat where the person responsible on board and at least 50% of all competitors on board are Swedish citizens. The title Swedish Champion is awarded only to the competitor who is a Swedish citizen.
- 2.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
- 2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 2.4 When the water temperature is below +14°C clothing given a good protection against cooling in water shall be worn wet suit, dry suit or similar.

#### 3. Entries

- 3.1 Entries with **reduced Entry fee** are accepted no later than **24 June**. Entries with **full Entry fee** are accepted up to **7th of July**.
- 3.2 The reduced Entry fee is **1 400 SEK** and shall be paid no later than **24 June**. The full entry fee is **2 000 SEK** for all entries made after **24 June**, but no later than **7 July**.

- 3.4 In the event that the regatta is canceled due to the Corona situation, the entire entry fee will be refunded.

### 4. Registration and measurement checks

- 4.1 Registrations shall be made at the race office no later than **Friday 8th July 2022** at **09:30**
- 4.2 Measurement certificates shall be presented prior to racing.
- 4.3 Valid insurance certificates shall be presented at the registration.
- 4.4 Competitor that is in charge onboard, according to §1.5 shall be able to present a valid license for competitor. This paragraph is valid only for Swedish competitors.
- 4.5 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, the race- or/and the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection.
- 4.6 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 4.7 A competitor may not be substituted without the written permission of the race committee.

5.2 Up to eleven (11) races are planned. 4 races on Friday, 4 races on Saturday and 3 on Sunday. May be subject to changes by race committee.

### 6. Race format

- 6.1 Gate start will be used. Subject to change by race committee
- 6.1 The championships will be conducted as a straight series.

# 7. Racing area

7.1 The racing areas will be held on the waters outside Gefle Segelsällskap's harbor. 2 racing areas can be used depending on weather and wind conditions. These can be found in a separate document in Sailarena.

#### 8. The course

8.1 Windward-leeward course will be sailed and the length of the course is planned for 50 minutes.

# 9. Protests and penalty systems

- 9.1 RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 9.2 RRS Appendix T1 will apply

# 10. Scoring

- 10.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

#### 11. Prizes

- 11.1 Winner of "No Emission Race" and for each fifth boat.

  Gold, silver and bronze plaques of Nordic Sailing federation will be awarded to the best three crews.
- 11.2 Riksidrottsförbundets Swedish Open Championship plaques in accordance with 2.1.

The Swedish 505 Associations trophy "Hornet" is awarded to the Swedish Champion.

The Swedish 505 Associations trophy "Classic" is awarded to the best 505 Classic team, where the whole team have been Swedish citizens at least six of the last twelve months. Classic boats are number 8554 and lower/older. Prize can be awarded to the best junior team, the best mix team and the best lady team.

### 12. Rules for support persons

- a) Support persons shall follow Swedish Sailing Federation safety code.
- b) Support person shall launch, berth and take up his craft (coach boat) as directed by the organizer.
- c) Support person shall follow RRS 1, 2 and 55 and not subject a competitor to risk breaking RRS 41.
- d) During the race, a support person shall not be closer to a competitor than 50 meters, except when the support person acting under RRS 1.1.
