

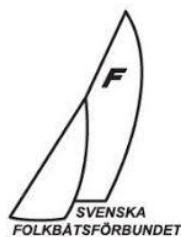
Notice of Race (NoR)

Swedish Championship Nordic Folkboat, open class

Category: Red

Dates: 12-16 August 2026

Organizing authority: Segelsällskapet Pinhättan (SSP)



1 Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 applies for competitors and support persons at all times while the boat or vessel is afloat. However, it does not apply for a keelboat when she is made fast or moored or if the competitor is below deck. (DP)
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2 Eligibility

- 2.1 Each participating boat shall be insured so that the person in charge is covered for liability claims up to at least 5 million SEK.
- 2.2 Each competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. A person in charge, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation and be a member of the appropriate class association.
- 2.3 A competitor shall be at least twelve years old the year the event takes place.
- 2.4 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the competition.

3 Entry

- 3.1 Boats may enter the event by registering online at Sailarena no later than Sunday 26th of July 2026 at 22:00. Late entries are accepted until 6th of August 2026 at 22:00.

- 3.2 The entry fee is 3200 SEK to be paid with BG 307-7625, Swish 123 156 61 81 or by credit card when making the entry. For credit card payment e-mail tavling@pinhattan.se.
Late entry is accepted for an increased entry fee of 1000 SEK per boat.
If the entry is withdrawn no later than 1st of August 2026, or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee will be refunded.
The entry fee include:
 - Boat launch and lift with crane.
 - Car and trailer parking.
 - Mooring place during the regatta.
 - Regatta dinner for the crew on Saturday evening (extra tickets can be purchased, see practical info.).
 - After-sail with simple food and drinks.

4 Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registration shall be made at the race-office in the SSP's clubhouse no later than Thursday 13th of August 2026 at 9:45.
- 4.2 Boat data and information about all crew members shall be updated in Sailarena before registration at the race-office.

- 4.3 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify valid insurance, club membership for all members of the crew, competition license (Tävlingslicens) when applicable and valid measurement certificate.
- 4.4 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.
- 4.5 The target is to weigh 20% of all participating boats. Which boats will be weighed are selected at random and the selection will be posted on the official notice board.
- 4.6 Svenska Folkbåtsförbundet intends to measure the floating angle of a number of boats in order to create statistics for a possible upcoming change of the class rules. Which boats will be measured are selected at random and the selection will be posted on the official notice board.
- 4.7 A competitor who has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the race committee. However, the person in charge may not be changed.
- 4.8 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless authorised by the race committee or the technical committee, unless class rules say otherwise.

5 Sailing instructions and information

- 5.1 Sailing instructions and other official information will be available on the official notice board at <https://www.sailarena.com/sv/se/club/ssp/sm-nordisk-folkbat-2026>.
- 5.2 The race committee will, when possible and appropriate, broadcast information regarding the course, starting times, safety etc. on VHF channel 69 (backup 72).

6 Schedule

7 Format

7.1 8 races are scheduled.

8 Venue and course

8.1 The races will be on the waters just outside of Barsebäckshamn.

8.2 The course will be a windward/leeward course as described in the sailing instructions.

9 Protests and penalties

9.1 RRS appendix P will apply.

9.2 RRS appendix T will apply.

9.3 In RRS 44.1 "Two-Turns Penalty" is changed to "One-Turn Penalty".

10 Scoring

10.1 RRS 90.3e applies.

10.2 RRS A2.1 is changed so that with three or less races, no score will be excluded. After more than three races the worst score will be excluded.

10.3 Three races are required to constitute a championship.

11 Prizes

11.1 Swedish Mästerskapstecken 2026 in Gold, Silver and Bronze for Nordic Folkboat will be awarded the 1st, 2nd and 3rd crews.

11.2 For the awarding of Mästerskapstecken, SSF:s Tävlingsreglemente, Mästerskapsbestämmelser apply.

11.3 The winner of the Swedish championship is invited to Seglingens Mästare according to the terms and conditions specified by that competition's Inbjudan (notice of race). Entry to Seglingens Mästare shall be registered, online at Sailarena, no later than 14 days after the Swedish championship has been completed.

12 Photo and media

12.1 By participating in the regatta competitors accept that photos and video from the regatta will be published on different media associated with Svenska Folkbåtsförbundet, Nordic Folkboat International Association and Segelsällskapet Pinhättan. Publication from the regatta takes place without the explicit approval of the competitors and without any compensation being paid.
