1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS T1 will apply.
- 1.3 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.4 In all rules governing this regatta, (NP) denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 3.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the official signal mast (OSM) next to the race office, located in Ystads Segelsällskap's clubhouse at Ystad Marina.
- 3.2 Postponement Signal AP displayed ashore means: "Races not started are postponed. The warning signal will be made not less than 60 minutes after removal unless at that time the race is postponed again or abandoned." This changes RRS Race Signals AP.

5 CLASS FLAG

5.1 The Class flag will be flag "F".

6 COURSE AREA

6.1 The course area will be located at the sea southwest of Ystad Marina.

7 THE COURSE AND MARKS

- 7.1 **Appendix A** shows the course, the marks, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. This changes RRS S7.2.
- 7.2 The length of the course will be set for a target time for the first finishing boat of 60 minutes. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

8 THE START

8.1 A boat starting later than 10 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start, without a hearing. This changes RRS A4 and A5.

9 TIME LIMITS

9.1 Following time limits will apply:

Mark 1 Time Limit: 30 minutes Race Time Limit: 90 minutes Finish Window: 30 minutes

10 SAFETY (DP, NP)

10.1 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee or the race office as soon as possible.

Appendix A Course and marks

Course: Start, 1 (port), 1a (port), 4s/4b (gate*), 1 (port),

1a (port) and Finish

(*): If one of the gate marks is missing, the remaining mark

shall be passed and left on the port side.

Starting mark: Race committee boat or buoy displaying an orange flag

Mark 1: Inflatable orange cylinder

Mark 1a: Buoy with a staff displaying an orange flag

Mark 4s, 4b: Inflatable yellow cylinders
Finishing mark: Buoy displaying a blue flag
