Skanörs Båtklubb and Sundsgymnasiet invite all iQFOiL and Waszp sailors to this foiling event in Skanör!

Skanör is a beautiful sailing spot in the very south of Sweden and offers great sailing and racing conditions just outside of the harbor. Racing days are Saturday and Sunday but we welcome you to join the bonanza already on Friday for registration, hangout and free barbecue for competitors as well as an opportunity to try out wingfoil, Waszp, SUP and other water activities.

After each day of iQFOiL and Waszp racing we will arrange a fun race in Wingfoil. Bring your own wing and board! We have a few wing packages that you can borrow for this race.

Next to the racing area there's hiking trails, restaurants and beaches. So bring your family and join the Foiling Bonanza in Skanör!

1. Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and with appendix S.

The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board (ONB).

- 1.2 RRS Appendix B will apply, however RRS B5 61.1(a) and B8.A8 are deleted.
- 1.3 All boats/boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.





- 1.4 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee. Wetsuits and drysuits are not personal flotation devices.
- 1.5 When the water temperature is below +14°C a competitor shall wear clothes that prevents from hypothermia, i.e., wetsuit or drysuit.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All boards competing shall be insured so that the person in charge is covered for liability claims up to at least 5 million Swedish kronor.
- 2.2 Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. A person in charge, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 2.3 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the event.

3. Entry

- 3.1 Boats may enter the event by registering online at <u>Sailarena.se</u> not later than June 5th.
- 3.2 The minimum number of entries in all classes are 6, to ensure a separate start group. If the number of entries does not reach the minimum number until May 31th 2024, the class/event may be combined with another class to form a start group.
- 3.3 The entry fee is 500 SEK to be paid in Sailarena when making the entry. If the entry is withdrawn not later than May 31th, or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee will be refunded except for an administration fee of 100 SEK.
- 3.4 Early registrations done before May 10th 2024 have an entry fee of a total 400 SEK.
- 3.5 Late entry is possible until June 5th 2024 with an entry fee of 600 SEK.

4. Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registration should be made in Sailarena no later than 12.00 June 5th.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership, competition license and valid measurement certificate or similar.





4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.

5. Sailing instructions and information

- 5.1 The sailing regulations consist of RRS appendix S, Standard sailing regulations, Supplementary sailing instructions and other official information will be available on the official notice board at Skanör Foiling Bonanza Sailarena.
- 5.2 The race committee will, when possible and appropriate, broadcast information regarding the course, starting times, safety etc. on VHF channel 72.

7. Format

- 7.1 10 races are scheduled for iQFOiL and 8 races for Waszp.
- 7.2 The event will consist of a ground serie of races with all boats in the same class in the same fleet.

8. Venue and course

- 8.1 The racing area will be just outside Skanör Harbor.
- 8.2 The racing committee will choose racing discipline based on the weather situation/forecast. The courses will be further described in the sailing instructions.

9. Protests and penalties

- 9.1 RRS T1 will apply.
- 9.2 In addition to penalties provided in RRS 64.2, the protest committee may penalize a boat in accordance with RRS 44.3c.

10. Scoring

- 10.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores
- 10.2 The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided for in RRS 90.3e.

11. Prizes

11.1 One prize per 5 boats, minimum 3 and maximum 10 prizes per class

12. Rules for support persons

- 12.1 Support person shall launch, berth and take up his craft (coach boat) as directed by the organizer.
- 12.2 Support person shall follow RRS 1, 2 and 55 and not subject a competitor to risk breaking RRS 41.





- 12.3 Support and coach boats should be registered at the race office.
- 12.4 During the race, a support person shall not be closer to a competitor than 50 meters, except when the support person acts under RRS 1.1.
