Notice of Race

OPEN SWEDISH CHAMPIONSHIP FOR STARBOATS, JUNE 16 - 19, 2022

Event: Swedish Championship for Starboats

Date: June 16 - 19, 2022

Organizer: Karlshamn Sailing Society (KSS), Sweden

Sailing area: Sweden, South of Karlshamn in Hanöbukten

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA). The organizing Authority is Karlshamn Sailing Society (KSS).
- 1.2 Unmanned fleet racing may be used in addition to protest hearings as described in the sailing instructions. This changes RRS part 5, sections A and B.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 1.4 The prescriptions of the national authority shall apply.
- 1.5 RRS 35 will be changed to provide those boats not finishing within 30 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored as "Did Not Finish" without hearing.
- 1.6 RRS 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be re-opened on the last day of racing.
- 1.7 RRS A4.1 will be changed to provide that a boat failing to check in prior to the warning signal, will be scored the same as a boat not starting in that race without a hearing. The check in must be done before the first race on each racing day.
- 1.8 All Boats shall in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20 display advertising provided by the event organizer, if applicable. The advertising shall, if applicable, be carried on both sides of the hull.
- 1.9 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. However, it does not apply on a keelboat when it is moored or when the competitor is below deck. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee

1.10 In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions and Supplementary Instructions shall take precedence. This changes rule 63.7.

1.11 All entries, when accepted, will be displayed on the organizer website. This display can be considered as a confirmation included publishing of photos taken during the event by organizers photographers.

2 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 To be entitled to participate in Riksidrottsförbundets championships, each competitor must comply with World Sailing Regulation 19. To be awarded the title Swedish Champion (SM) the skipper shall be Swedish citizen. Championship plaque and titles may be awarded if six or more boats from at least three different clubs located in more than one district have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.
- 2.2 Only skippers and crew eligible to compete under the World Sailing Eligibility Code shall be eligible to compete in this regatta.
- 2.3 Skipper must be an active member of ISCYRA and have a racing license from the Swedish Sailing Federation (not valid for foreign citizens). Contact Lars Nordling.
- 2.4 A competitor shall be at least twelve years old the same year this event takes place.
- 2.5 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 2.6 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. Insurance policy to be verified at registration or at request.

- 3.5 Entry fee will be refunded only in case if serious sickness or accident occur.

- 3.6 The regatta dinner is included in the entry fee for the attending crews and shall be booked separately. Guests may be invited and paid for separately.

A separate invitation will be sent out in good time before the regatta.

- 3.7 No entries will be accepted after June 13, 2022.

4 REGISTRATION AND MEASUREMENT CHECKS

- 4.1 Registrations of the whole crew shall be made at the race office not later than 10:00, June 17, 2022.

- 4.2 Each participating boat shall have a valid Measurement Certificate, a valid competition license, and a Weight Certificate.

- 4.3 Each boat shall show the same sail number and national letters as indicated in the entry.

- 4.4 Spot checks may be done prior to the races and after each day's races.

- 4.5 A competitor that has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the race committee.

- 4.6 Launching and hauling will be at Karlshamns Sailing Society in Karlshamn, Sweden

- 4.7 All boats will be berthed at the Yacht Club

- 4.8 The regatta office is located at the Yacht Club

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be handed out at registration.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Programme:

Wednesday, June 15:

- Registration at regatta office, boat launch 16.00-20.00

Thursday, June 16:

- Registration and Measurement, boat launch, safety inspection 08.00- 20.00
- Tune up races are planned to start at the latest: 14.00
- Tune Up After Sail from 17.00

Friday, June 17:

- Opening ceremony at KSS club house and Skippers briefing: 09.00
- Time for the first warning signal: 11.00
- After sail as soon as the day's race is over

Saturday, June 18:

- Skippers briefing will be announced if necessary 09.00
- Time for first warning signal 11.00
- Regatta dinner approx. 18.00

Sunday, June 19:

- Skippers briefing will be announced if necessary 09.00
- Time for the first warning signal 10.00
- No warning signal will be given after 15.00 unless it follows a signal of general recall or postponement of a race whose first warning signal had been made before 15.00.

- 6.2 Price giving ceremony as soon as possible after finishing the races and protest hearings. A separate price given for winning the tune up race.
- 6.3 Boat that has a long journey home will be given priority at boat haul out.
- 6.4 Seven (7) races are planned in total over three racing days

7 RACE FORMAT

- 7.1 There will be no division race. One-fleet races are scheduled.

8 RACING AREA

- 8.1 The racing areas will be on the water south Karlshamn.

9 THE COURSE

- 9.1 Courses will be sailed according to ISCYRA rules.

10 PROTESTS & PENALTY SYSTEMS

- 10.1 RRS P will apply.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, modified so that each series score will be the total of her races score with her worst score exclude if more than three (3) races are completed.

- 11.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

- 11.3 The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided for in RRS 90.3e

12 PRIZES

- 12.1 Perpetual prize to the winner, Swedish Championship (SM) plaque and titles will be awarded to top three (3) Swedish boats.

- 12.2 Championship plaque and titles may be awarded if six or more boats from at least three different Swedish clubs located in more than one Swedish district have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.

- 12.3 One prize per five participating boats.

13 Data protection

- 13.1 In order to manage the events, information provided by competitors will be held on a database. The management of personal information and images will comply with the GDPR legislation

14 Rights and copyright

- 14.1 By participating in this race, a competitor automatically grants the Organizing Authority, the National and International Class Associations and the sponsors of the event the right in perpetuity to make, use and show at their discretion any motion pictures, still pictures and live taped or filmed television and other reproductions of his/her material related to the international championship, without compensation.

Boat lift will be possible directly after the race is over on Sunday June 19. Boats that have a long journey back home will be given priority.

You may to arrive with the boat in advance of the regatta and leave the boat in Karlshamn before the European Championships in Denmark.
