



INVITATION to RIKSCUP 606 and KONA SM 2018 in LIDKÖPING

1. EVENT

- 1.1 The Competition will be held from Saturday 29th of September to Sunday 30th of September 2018.
- 1.2 this Competition is Level no.2 Event factor : 1.
- 1.3 a 606-competition will take place simultaneous.

2. ORGANIZER

- 2.1 The Competition will be organized by SSW / Segelsällskapet Westgötarne for and on behalf of the Swedish Sailing Federation (SSF) and www.konaone.com (mailsponsor)

3. VENUE

- 3.1 The event will be held at Framnäs Yacht harbour and surrounding areas, Lidköping

4. RULES

- 4.1 This is an event governed by the Swedish Sailing Federation (SSF).
 - 4.1.1 The ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing.
 - 4.1.2 The Kona Class Rules.
 - 4.1.3. No National Authority prescriptions will apply
- 4.2 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions (SI's) , the SI will take precedence.
- 4.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 4.4 Sail sizes and weight groups as the standard class rules.

5. ADVERTISING

- 5.1 ISAF Regulation 20 – Advertising Code shall apply.
- 5.2 Competitors may be required to carry advertising for event sponsors – both on their sails, and on a lycra vest if supplied by the organiser.

6. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 6.1 All entries shall meet the requirements of ISAF Regulation 19 – Eligibility Code.
- 6.2 Competitors shall be members of the National Class Association.
- 6.3 Membership formalities can be completed on site.
- 6.4 Entries shall be online via www.konaone.com
- 6.5 Competitors shall provide the following documentation prior to completing registration formalities on site:
 - Proof of Entry registration formalities on site: Fee payment
 - Evidence of valid third party insurance
 - Proof of age
 - Parental/legal Guardian Assent – for those under the age of 18.
 - Medical Treatment Permission – for those under age of 18 or on their parents medical insurance policy.



7. FEES

8. RACING FORMAT, CLASSES & DIVISIONS

8.1 All divisions will apply to the Kona Class Rules.

8.2 The competition shall be a "open entry" event.

8.3 The maximum "fleet size" shall be 100.

8.4 One fleet is Kona Class.

8.5 The fleet may be split into two equal fleets followed by a final.

9.2 The scheduled time of warning signal for the first race each day is 09.55 hrs.

9.3 The racing schedule may be altered, and is governed by the SI's.



10. EQUIPMENT

- 10.1 It is the responsibility of each competitor to ensure that his/her board and equipment conforms to it's Class Rule.
- 10.2 Equipment checks may be made throughout the event.
- 10.3 Competitors shall bring their own equipment.

11. SAILING INSTRUKTIONS

- 11.1 The SI's will be available at registration and posted on the official noticeboard.

12. COURSES

- 12.1 Courses shall be as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions and will be posted on the official noticeboard on the day of racing.

13. SCORING

- 13.1 Scoring will be in accordance with WCR Appendix A using the " Low Point Scoring System".

14. STORAGE OF EQUIPMENT

- 14.1 Please note that each competitor has her/his own responsibility of storing and safekeeping of equipment.

15. MEDALS AND PRICES

- 15.1 Medals shall be awarded in each class/division.
- 15.2 Medals/trophies shall be awarded to the first three competitors, in each class/division.

16. BUOYANCY

- 16.1 Personal buoyancy in mandatory for all competitors.

17. DISCALIMER OF LIABILITY

- 17.1 Competitors take part in all races at their own risk. The organizer, Kona Class association or any of their officials or representatives or any sponsors or their officials or representatives are not responsible, under any circumstances, for any damage, loss or injury either ashore or on the water either to persons or equipment, which may result.
- 17.2 Participation in this event, supporting events and in each race in them is as a sole discretion of the sailor and hat her/his own risk.

18. INSURANCE

18.1 Competitors shall propose valid third party insurance with a minimum cover of 300.000 Euro.

19. MEDIA

19.1 In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, and motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped and filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of event, for the said competition as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing instructions in which she/he participates without Compensation.

20. INFORMATION ACCOMMODATION
