

Notice of Race (NoR)

Swedish Championship for Finn and OK Dinghy.

Date: 24th of August to 27th of August 2023

Location: Skutberget Karlstad

Boatclass: Finn and OK Dinghy

Organizers: Karlstads Kappseglingsförening (KKF), Skoghalls Båtsällskap (ShBS) and Karlstads Segelsällskap (KdSS).

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) with appendix S, the Swedish Class Rules for Finn and OK-dinghy and Swedish National Prescriptions.
- 1.2 Swedish Class Rules for Finn and OK-dinghy.
- 1.3 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.
- 1.4 When the water temperature is below +14°C a competitor shall wear clothes that prevents from hypothermia, i.e., wetsuit or drysuit.

2. Eligibility requirements

- 2.1 In order to be awarded the title Swedish Champion (SM) the competitors shall be Swedish citizens
- 2.2 All boats competing shall have a third-party liability insurance.
- 2.3 The event is "open class"







- 2.4 Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. Every competitor who is a Swedish citizen shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 2.5 A competitor shall be at least twelve (12) years old the year the event takes place.
- 2.6 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the event.
- 2.7 Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

3. Entries

3.1 Boats may enter the event by registering online at Sailarena not later than 29th of July 2023 - and include the information requested in the form (name of skipper, skippers age, sailing class, sail number, nationality, email and mobile phone number).

The registration is not valid until the entry fee is received by the organizer, not later than 14th of August 2023.

3.2 The entry fee is 1100 SEK and shall be paid to:

Please supply: "SM", name of skipper and sail number.

If the entry is withdrawn not later than 7 days before the event, or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee will be refunded.

3.3 After 29th of July 2023, late entry can be made not later than 21th of August 2023 with an additional fee of 500 SEK. Entry fee for late entry, total of 1600 SEK shall be paid no later than 21st of August 2023. Entry after 21st of August 2023 is not allowed.







4. Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registrations shall be made at the race office at Skutbergets motionscentral not later than 09:00 on Friday 25th of August 2023.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership, competition license and valid measurement certificate or similar. For Swedish citizens: check of membership in "Finnjolleförbundet" or "OK-jolleförbundet" may be performed.
- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.
- 4.4 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

5. Sailing instructions and information

5.1 Sailing instructions and other official information will be available on the digital official notice board at <u>https://www.kkfsegling.se/tavlingar/tavlingar-2023/sm-2023/</u>.

6. Time schedule

Prizegiving ceremony will be held at Skutberget as soon as possible after the results are finalized.

7. Format

- 7.1 <u>8</u> races are scheduled for both Finn and OK Dinghy.
- 7.2 The event will be held as a fleet racing in a straight series.

8. Venue and course

- 8.1 The racing area will be south of Skutberget on Kattfjorden.
- 8.2 The course will be a windward/leeward course as described in the sailing instructions.

9. Protests and penalty systems

- 9.1 RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 9.2 RRS Appendix T1 will apply

10. Scoring

- 10.1 RRS A5.3 will apply.
- 10.2 The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided for in RRS 90.3e.
- 10.3 **RRS** A2.1 is changed so that with three (3) or less races, no score will be excluded. After more than three races one (1) score will be excluded.
- 10.4 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

11. Prizes

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd boat in the competition. For special prizes in the separate classes see attachment.
- 11.2 Championship plaquette and titles may be awarded if six or more boats from at least three different Swedish clubs located in more than one Swedish district have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.

12. Rules for support persons

- a) Support persons shall follow Swedish Sailing Federation safety code.
- b) Support person shall launch, berth and take up his craft (coach boat) as directed by the organizer.
- c) Support person shall follow RRS 1, 2 and 55 and not subject a competitor to risk breaking RRS 41.







d) During the race, a support person shall not be closer to a competitor than 50 meters, except when the support person acting under RRS 1.1.

13. Media rights and data privacy

- 13.1 By participating in the event, the competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
- 13.2 By participating in the event, the competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right to store the personal information requested in the entry form until the completion of the event.
- 13.3 By participating in the event, the competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to publish competitor name, nationality and sail number in competitor and result lists.

14. Sustainability

Lake Vänern is the largest freshwater source in Sweden and thus sensitive for pollution. All sailors, coaches, race officials and volunteers are responsible for not to damage the health of our waters. We are committed to limiting the negative environmental impacts of the event and we expect everyone involved to follow the below guidelines.

- 14.1 A competitor shall not intentionally put trash in the water.
- 14.2 All waste must be disposed of in proper containers: Recycling & Landfill.
- 14.3 Prevent marine debris. Keep your trash secure on board so it does not blow into the water.
- 14.4 When fueling, please fill fuel tanks slowly and use absorbent pads to catch drips and spills. Do not overflow your fuel tank. Try to leave the tank 10% empty to allow fuel to expand as it warms.
- 14.5 The organizer will endeavor to limit all unnecessary emissions from fossil fuel engines from boats serving the races such as race committee vessel, jury boats, safety boats, etc.
