

1. RULES

The organizing authority is Marstrand Sailing Association in cooperation with

606 Association

The Event will be hosted at Marstrand.

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1.1

The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)

1.2

606 lass rules will apply.

Swedish National prescriptions do apply and will be published on the official notice located at Sail Arena

1.3

[NP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

1.4

RRS 40.1 applies at all times a boat is on the water, but it does not apply to a keelboat when the boat is moored or for a competitor that is under deck. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices.

A boat that violates this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee(DP).

15

The person that is in charge on board shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This regulation applies from the year the competitor reach the age of 12. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation

1.6

It is allowed to use VHF. The race committee will, if possible, inform every start sequence or other information on channel 72^* .

* Channel may be changed at skippers briefing

1.7

If there is a conflict between information in NoR and SI, then SI takes precedence.

2. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

2.1

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance

2.2

Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority.

2.3

The person who is responsible on board, is a Swedish citizen or has resided in Sweden for at least six of the last twelve months before the regatta is carried out and turns at least 12 years old in the year the competition is carried out, must have a competition license issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.

Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation.

2.4

To be entitled to participate in the Swedish Sport Federation championships, each competitor must be at age 12 years or older at the year of the regatta.

2.5

If less than 15 participants, the organization reserves the right to cancel the regatta

2.6

A competitor shall be at least twelve years old the year the event takes place.

2.7

Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the competition.

3. FNTRIES AND FFES

3.1

Entry and payment shall be made not later than 31st July and sent to www.sailarena.se see 3.3 or as described in 3.4.

- The entry fee is 1.800 SEK until 31st July
- Late entry fee is 2.200 SEK after 31st July until 10st August

3.2

The entry fee includes:

- Friday After-Sail
- Saturday After-Sail
- · Launching, retrieving and docking
- Trailer and car parking at designated place
- Mooring at the H-jetty on Marstrand island
- Fee to the Swedish Sailing Sailing Federation with 100 SEK
- Fee to the West Coast Sailing Federation with 42 SEK
- MaSS costs for the sailing event

3.3

The Entry shall include the following:

3.5

The whole entry fee will be paid back if cancellation is made before the closing date 31st July

3.6

The entire entry fee will be refunded if the championship is cancelled due to too few participants – see point 2.5

4 REGISTRATION AND MEASUREMENT CHECK

4.1

Registration of all crew must be done in Sailarena not later than Friday 11th August 09.30 hours

4.2

The person in charge on board must be able to prove club membership, any competition license and the boat's measurement certificate or equivalent.

4.3

A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, the race- or/and the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection. But not when the boat has started the race, but as soon as possible after the race is finished.

4.4

Random measurement or secure checks may be done.

4.5

A competitor who has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the racing committee but not the person who is in charge on board.

4.6

Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

5.1

Sailing Instructions and other official information will be available on the official noticeboard on www.sailarena.se and also on the official noticeboard located outside Strandverket.

5.2

The Racing Committee will, when possible and appropriate, send information about the course, start times, safety, etc. on VHF channel 72 or channel communicated at skippers briefing.

8.1


The racing areas will be on the Marstrand fiord (west of the Marstrand island)

The course is to be sailed: START - 1s/1b - 2s/2b - 1s/1b - 2b - Finish.

9.2

The regatta committee grants them self their right to change the design of the course and the number of loops.

10. PROTESTS AND PENALTY SYSTEMS

10.1

Amending RRS § 44.1 and § 44.2 changes the two-turn penalty to one-turn penalty.

10.2

RRS appendix T will apply

11. SCORING

11.1

The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed; a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11.2

RRS rule A5.3 will apply.

11.3

With change of the rule RRS 90.3e the Racing Committee does not make any changes to the results 12 hours after the last race in accordance with the conditions set out in RRS 90.3e.

11.4

RRS A2.1 is changed so that in the case of three or fewer completed races, all are counted and in the case of more than three completed races, the worst may be counted out.

11.5

A minimum of 3 races must be completed to constitute a Swedish Championship

2. PRIZES

11.1

Championship plaquettes from Riksidrottsförbundet in gold, silver and bronze and titles may be awarded if six or more boats from at least three different Swedish clubs located in more than one Swedish district have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.

11.2

The Swedish Sailing Federation Regulations for Competition 2021, chapter 8 Championship will apply for the awarding of championship plaques

11.3

MaSS prizes to 20 % of the participants

11.4

Possible sponsor prizes

11.5

Prizes from the 606 Association

11.6

The winner of the Swedish championship is invited to the competition Sailing Champion according to the conditions stated in that competition's invitation. Registration for the Sailing Champion must be made in Sailarena no later than 14 days after the Swedish championship has been completed.


APPENDIX 1
