Supplementary Sailing Instructions

1. Race office and Signal pole

- 1.1 Race office is located in GKSS club house.
- 1.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag pole marked with a blue flag next to the berthing ramp.
- 1.3 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 45 minutes' in RRS Race Signals.

2. Schedule

First Warning signal 10:55

Sunday May 4th

First Warning signal 10:25

2.2 No Warning signal will be made after 15.00 on Sunday the 4th

3 Marks

3.1 The Startmark to windward (starboard) is the committee boat with orange flag. The Startmark to leeward (port) is a rib-boat with orange flag.

Mark 1, Mark 2s, Mark 2p are yellow cylinder bouys.

Mark 1a will be a "red ball" bouy.

The finish mark is the committee boat.


The finish mark is a flag bouy with a blue flag


3.2 Upon a change of a leg, the "New Mark" will be an orange cylinder bouy. (see 6.5 for procedure)

4 The Course

- 4.1 The course can be shared with other classes
- 4.2 The Course (see diagram below) to be sailed: START 1 1a 2s/2p (Gate) 1 1a 2p FINISH

4.3 If, Numeral Pennant 3 (RED/WHITE/BLUE) is displayed on the race committee boat, no later than together with the Warning signal an extra lap is added. The Course (see diagram below) shall then be sailed:





5 Time limits

- 5.1 The race time limit is 45 min
- 5.2 The finishing window is 15 min.

6. Changes and additions to appendix S

- 6.1 To alert boats that a new starting sequence is about to begin, the orange flag on the starting line will be displayed with a sound signal not less than <u>two minutes</u> before the warning signal. This changes Appenix S 5.2
- 6.2 The Flag G will be used as class flag. This changes Appendix S 6.1
- 6.3 The startline is between the orange flags displayed on the committee boat and the startmark. This changes Appendix S 9.2
- 6.4 The Finish line is between the blueflag displayed on the committee boat and the flag bouy
- 6.5 A boat that does not start within <u>four minutes</u> after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS) without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2
- 6.6 RRS 33 is changed to:
 - While boats are racing, the race committee may change a leg of the course.

 (a) Minor adjustments can be made by changing the position of the next mark or gate before the first boat has rounded the previous mark, adjustments will be made without signalling.

(b) Other adjustments will be made by placing the New Mark before the first boat has rounded the previous mark and signalling all boats before they begin the leg. If a further adjustment is made the Original Mark is placed. Signal flag C together with repetitive sounds is a sufficient signal when changing position of the new mark. This changes RRS 33.
