



Notice of Race (NoR)

Falsterbo Sailing Bonanza

Dates: 10-11 Maj 2025
Location: Falsterbokanalen
Boatclass: iQFOiL 8,0m
Waszp (6,9m and 8,2m)

Falsterbokanalens båtklubb and Sundsgymnasiet invite all iQFOiL and Waszp sailors to this foiling event in Falsterbokanalen!

Falsterbokanalen is a beautiful sailing spot in the very south of Sweden and offers great sailing and racing conditions just outside of the harbor. Racing days are Saturday and Sunday but we welcome you to join the Bonanza already on Friday for registration and opening ceremony.

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and with appendix S.
The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board (ONB).
- 1.2 RRS Appendix B will apply, however RRS B5 61.1(a) and B8.A8 are deleted.
- 1.3 All boats/boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 1.4 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee. Wetsuits and drysuits are not personal flotation devices.
- 1.5 When the water temperature is below +14°C a competitor shall wear clothes that prevents from hypothermia, i.e., wetsuit or drysuit.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All vessels competing shall be insured so that the person in charge is covered for liability claims up to at least 5 million Swedish kronor.



2.2 Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. A person in charge, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.

2.3 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the event.

3. Entry

3.1 Boats may enter the event by registering online at [Sailarena.se](https://sailarena.se) not later than May 5th.

3.2 The minimum number of entries in all classes are 6, to ensure a separate start group. If the number of entries does not reach the minimum number until May 5th 2025, the class/event may be combined with another class to form a start group.

3.3 The entry fee is 700 SEK to be paid in Sailarena when making the entry. If the entry is withdrawn not later than May 5th, or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee will be refunded except for an administration fee of 100 SEK.

3.4 Late entry is possible until May 9th 2025 with an entry fee of 900 SEK.

4. Registration and equipment inspection

4.1 Registration should be made in Sailarena no later than 18.00 May 9th.

4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership, competition license and valid measurement certificate or similar.

4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.

5. Sailing instructions and information

5.1 The sailing regulations consist of RRS appendix S, Standard sailing regulations, Supplementary sailing instructions and other official information will be available on the official notice board at [Falsterbo Sailing Bonanza - Sailarena](https://falsterbo.sailingbonanza.se).

5.2 The race committee will, when possible and appropriate, broadcast information regarding the course, starting times, safety etc. on VHF channel 72.



6. Schedule

7. Format

- 7.1 10 races are scheduled for iQFOiL and 8 races for Waszp.
- 7.2 The event will consist of a ground serie of races with all boats in the same class in the same fleet and a grand final with the top three boats/boards from the ground serie.

8. Venue and course

- 8.1 The racing area will be north of the Falsterbo canal.
- 8.2 The race committee will choose racing discipline based on the weather situation/forecast. The courses will be further described in the sailing instructions.



9. Protests and penalties

9.1 RRS T1 will apply.

10. Scoring

10.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply for the ground series, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores

10.2 The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided for in RRS 90.3e.

11. Prizes

11.1 One prize per 5 boats, minimum 3 and maximum 10 prizes per class

12. Rules for support persons

12.1 Support person shall launch, berth and take up his craft (coach boat) as directed by the organizer.

12.2 Support person shall follow RRS 1, 2 and 55 and not subject a competitor to risk breaking RRS 41.

12.3 Support and coach boats should be registered at the race office.

12.4 During the race, a support person shall not be closer to a competitor than 50 meters, except when the support person acts under RRS 1.1.

13. Media rights - Copyright

13.1 By participating in the competition, the competitor agrees that the organizing authority, their sponsors and the designated rights holder have the right to use and publish images, videos and audio recordings from the regatta without compensation in perpetuity. This also applies to images, videos and audio recordings reported by third parties.
