1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The International 505 Class Rules and the Swedish 606 Class Rules apply.
- 1.2 All boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.
- 1.3 RRS 40.1 (*Personal Flotation Devices*) applies for competitors and support persons at all times while the boat or vessel is afloat. **(DP)** [DP = Discretionary Penalty: not grounds for protest by another boat]
- 1.4 When the water temperature is below +14°C a competitor shall wear clothes that prevent hypothermia, e.g. wetsuit or drysuit. **(DP)**
- 1.5 RRS 88.2 (*National Prescriptions*) – the prescriptions of the Swedish Sailing Federation (SSF) to the Racing Rules of Sailing shall apply.
- 1.6 RRS 44.1 is changed so that a boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or Rule 31 in an incident while racing. RRS 44.2 (*One-Turn and Two-Turns Penalties*) shall apply: after getting well clear of other boats as soon after the incident as possible, the boat shall promptly make one complete 360° turn (one tack and one gybe) in compliance with RRS 44.2.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 Each participating boat shall be insured so that the person in charge is covered for liability claims up to at least SEK 5,000,000.
- 2.2 The event is open to any boats of the International 505 and 606 classes.
- 2.3 Each competitor shall be a member of their National class Association and a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or their national authority. A person in charge who is a Swedish citizen shall have a competition licence issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 2.4 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors who are Russian or Belarusian citizens, are not allowed to participate.

3. Entry

- 3.1 Boats may enter the event by registering online at Sailarena:
<https://www.sailarena.com/sv/se/club/yss/yss-cup-2026/> Entry deadline: **2026-06-07**.
- 3.2 The entry fee is SEK 1,500 to be paid in Sailarena when making the entry. If the entry is withdrawn no later than 2026-05-31, or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organising authority, the entry fee will be refunded.

4. Registration and Equipment Inspection

- 4.1 Registration of the whole crew shall be made at the Regatta Office no later than 2026-06-13 at 09:00.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership and present a valid measurement certificate when so required.
- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water, the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.
- 4.4 A competitor may be replaced after approval by the race committee.

5. Sailing Instructions and Information

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the rules in RRS Appendix S (*Standard Sailing Instructions*) and supplementary Sailing Instructions that will be available on the Official Notice Board at: <https://www.sailarena.com/sv/se/club/yss/yss-cup-2026/>

7. Format

- 7.1 6 races per class are scheduled, with 3 planned races each day and a maximum of 4 races per day if the schedule requires.
- 7.2 The event will consist of a series of races with all boats in the same class in the same fleet. International 505 and 606 start separately as per Section 6 and are scored independently.

8. Venue and Course

- 8.1 Races will take place southwest of the harbour entrance in Ystad Bay.
- 8.2 The course will be a windward/leeward course as described in the Sailing Instructions.

9. Protests and Penalties

- 9.1 RRS Appendix P (*Special Procedures and Penalties at the Time of an Incident for Rule 42 – Propulsion*) will apply, except that P2.3 (*Third or Subsequent Infringement – automatic disqualification*) will not be used, and P2.2 (*Subsequent Infringement*) is changed from 'second time' to 'second and following times'.

10. Scoring

10.1 RRS Appendix A (*Scoring*), Low Point System (A4), will apply.

10.2 RRS 90.3(e) (*Scoring*) applies.

10.3 RRS A2.1 (*Series Scores*) is changed so that with three or fewer races completed, no score will be excluded. After more than three races have been completed, one score will be excluded.

11. Prizes

11.1 Prizes will be awarded for 1st to 3rd place in each class. One additional prize will be awarded for every 5 entries registered by 2026-05-31 beyond the first 15 entries.

12. Disclaimer of Liability

12.1 RRS 3 (*Decision to Race*): the responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.

12.2 The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the event.

12.3 By taking part in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that: (a) they are aware of the inherent risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such risk; (b) they are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their property whether afloat or ashore; (c) their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event, and they are fit to participate.

13. Data Protection

13.1 The personal information provided to the organising authority will be used to facilitate participation in the event. The legal basis for processing this information is the contractual relationship established by accepting the Racing Rules of Sailing and the rules governing this event. Personal information will be stored and used in accordance with the organising authority's privacy policy. When required by the rules, personal information may be shared with the Swedish Sailing Federation (SSF) and/or World Sailing. Results and the outcome of any hearings may be published.
