Time for the first warning signal 10.00 No warning signal will be given after 16.00

Prize giving ceremony as soon as possible after the races and protest hearings. Only to be attended in person by top 5 boats. Digital broadcasted as well.

Boats that have a long journey home will be given priority at the take up area.

- 1.2 Max 9 (nine) races are scheduled during the regatta
- 1.3 The race committee will try to set lay the course so that a race will take approximately 40 minutes to sail.

## 2. Location of the race office and information

- 2.1 The regatta office is in TäBK's klubbhus, Båthamnsvägen 18, 184 44 ÅKERSBERGA
- 2.2 Information to the contestants will apply on that will be posted on the official digital notice board, join Facebook group "Express SM 2020 Trälhavet/Åkersberga. LINK HERE.
- 2.3 During the regatta messages will also be send on VHF channel 72. Make sure to bring your own.

## 3. Marks

- 3.1 The rounding marks are yellow cylinder marks
- 3.2 When changing the course, the original mark will be moved. This changes AppSF 10.1

## 4. Time limits

- 4.1 Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 80 minutes.
- 4.2 Finishing window is 20 minutes.

## 5. Changes and additions to RRS appendix S

- 5.1 The course is a windward leeward course based on inner or outer loops. See course appendix. All marks are to be passed to port
- 5.2 Before the warning signal, the committee will show a flag with the color of the Groups to start. The flags will be lowered as soon as possible after starting procedure has ended.
- 5.3 If signal flag T is shown before or with the warning signal, the course will be sailed 3 loops, see description in course appendix.
- 5.3 The classflag is flag F. This changes AppSF 6.1.
- The Race committee will not show the course as stated in AppSF 7.1. This changes AppSF 7.1
- 5.4 The starting line is between an orange flag on the starting vessel and a spar buoy with an orange flag at the port end.

- 5.5 A boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. This changes RRS Appendix 4.
- 5.6 The finishing line is between a blue flag on the starting vessel and a spar buoy with a blue flag at the port end.

  This changes AppSF 11.1

## 6.0 Race format

- 6.1 For the qualifying series boats will be divided into four groups, Red, Blue, Green and Yellow, by the race committee. Will be presented after August 27, 18:00CET.
- 6.2 If all fleets have not completed the same number of races by the end of a day, the fleets with fewer races will continue racing the following day until all fleets have completed the same number of races.
- 6.2 **Up to six races per group** in heats as described below.

Two groups will sail together in each race:

#### Race 1:

Heat 1 Group Red and Blue (\*OL) Heat 2 Group Green and Yellow (\*IL)

#### Race 2:

Heat 3 Group Red and Green (\*OL) Heat 4 Group Blue and Yellow (\*IL)

#### **Race 3:**

Heat 5 Group Red and Yellow (\*OL) Heat 6 Group Blue and Green (\*IL)

#### Race 4:

Heat 7 Group Red and Blue (\*OL) Heat 8 Group Green and Yellow(\*IL)

#### Race 5:

Heat 9 Group Red and Green (\*OL) Heat 10 Group Blue and Yellow(\*IL)

### Race 6:

Heat 11 Group Red and Yellow(\*OL) Heat 12 Group Blue and Green (\*IL)

6.3 **Final Series:** Boats will be assigned to final series fleets Gold and Silver on the basis of their ranks in the qualifying series. Half, 50% (or if odd number, one more to Gold fleet) of the boat ranked highest in the qualifying series will be assigned to Gold fleet. Other part to Silver. New colour of the groups as below.

## Up to 3 final races

## Race 7:

Heat 13 Silver fleet, blue flag displayed on the starting vessel(\*OL)

Heat 14 Gold fleet, yellow flag displayed on the starting vessel(\*IL)

#### Race 8:

Heat 15 Gold fleet, yellow flag displayed on the starting vessel(\*OL)

Heat 16 Silver fleet, blue flag displayed on the starting vessel(\*IL)

#### Race 9:

Heat 17 Silver fleet, blue flag Gold fleet, yellow flag displayed on the starting vessel(\*OL)

Heat 18 Gold fleet, yellow flag displayed on the starting vessel(\*IL)

6.4 The race committee may change the starting order of the races.

<sup>\*</sup>OL or IL=Outer or inner loop, see courses

- 6.5 Flags with the same colour as the two groups up for start will be displayed on the starting vessel at the latest at the warning signal. The flags are lowered once the two groups have started.
- Outer loop will be displayed on the starting vessel marked with signal flag 1 (one) at the latest at the warning signal. The flag are lowered once the two groups have started.
- 6.7 Boats shall display a coloured ribbon corresponding to the colour of her fleet permanently fixed during the day's races.

The ribbons will be provided at Registration.

First heat in every race, outer loop "OL"
Marked by signal flag 1 (one) in starting procedure
Start-1-2-3-2-3 Finish


If signal flag T is shown before or with the warning signal, the course will be sailed,


Start-1-2-3-2-3-Finish

## Second heat in every race inner loop, "IL"

Start-1-4-1-4 Finish

If signal flag T is shown before or with the warning signal, the course will be sailed, Start-1-4-1-4-Finish





## Appendix: Orientation, harbours etc


## **Harbours:**
