



Notice of Race (NoR)

Swedish Master Championships and EurILCA Master Series

Dates: 28th to 30th August 2026

Location: Ystad Segelsällskap, Ystad, Sweden

Boat classes: ILCA 6 and ILCA 7

Organizing authority: Ystad Segelsällskap

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The General Notice of Race of the EurILCA Master Series 2026 (GNoR), [available here](#), applies.
- 1.3 All boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

- 1.4 RRS 40.1 applies for competitors and support persons at all times while the boat or vessel is afloat. This integrates with GNoR 13. (DP)
- 1.5 When the water temperature is below +14°C a competitor shall wear clothes that prevent hypothermia, e.g., a wetsuit or a drysuit. (DP)

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 Each participating boat shall be insured so that the person in charge is covered for liability claims up to at least 2 million Euros (2 000 000 €). This integrates with GNoR 19.1.
- 2.2 The event classes are ILCA 6 Master Open, ILCA 6 Master Woman and ILCA 7 Master.
- 2.3 Each competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. A person in charge, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation. Rules for class association membership are described in GNoR 2.2.
- 2.4 A competitor shall be at least 30 years old on 29th August 2026. This integrates with GNoR 2.4.
- 2.5 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the competition.

3. Entry

- 3.1 Boats may enter the event by registering at [Sailarena](#) no later than 23:59 on 14th August 2026.
- 3.2 The entry fee is 1350 SEK to be paid in Sailarena when making the entry. If an entry is withdrawn no later than 23:59 on 14th August 2026, or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee minus 200 SEK will be refunded on request to the Organizing Authority. Bank details shall be included in such a request.
- 3.3 Late entries are accepted to 23:59 on 21st August 2026. The late entry fee is 2700 SEK.

4. Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registration shall be made in person at the Race Office no later than 09:00 on 29th August 2026.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club and class association memberships and valid measurement certificate or similar when so required.

- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.

7. Format

- 7.1 6 races per class are scheduled, with 3 planned races each day and a maximum of 4 races in one day if the schedule requires.
- 7.2 The event will consist of a series of races with all boats in the same class in the same fleet. A class with more than 100 boats may be divided into smaller fleets with a qualifying series and a final series.

8. Venue and course

- 8.1 Races will take place southwest of the harbor entrance in Ystad Bay.
- 8.2 The course will be a trapezoid course as described in the sailing instructions.

9. Protests and penalties

- 9.1 RRS appendix P will apply with the following amendments:
- 9.1a If a first penalty is signalled after a boat has crossed the finish line, the penalty will be a 10% Scoring Penalty calculated as stated in RRS 44.3(c). However, she shall not be scored worse than DSQ.

9.1b RRS P4 is replaced with “An action by the jury under RRS P1.2 shall not be grounds for a request for redress by a boat under RRS 61.1(a). The jury may initiate a redress hearing and may give redress for an action under RRS P1.2 by a member of the jury or its designated observers.

9.2 RRS T1 will apply.

10. Scoring

10.2 RRS 90.3e applies.

10.3 RRS A2.1 is changed and GNoR 14.1 applies.

10.4 Three races are required to constitute a championship.

11. Prizes

11.1 One prize per every five boats with entries made as stated in 3.1, in each category, as defined in GNoR 15.1.

11.2 The title Swedish Champion, and championship medals may only be awarded to Swedish citizens. They will be awarded according to The Swedish Sailing Federation's [Tävlingsreglemente 2026](#), chapter 5 (written in Swedish).
